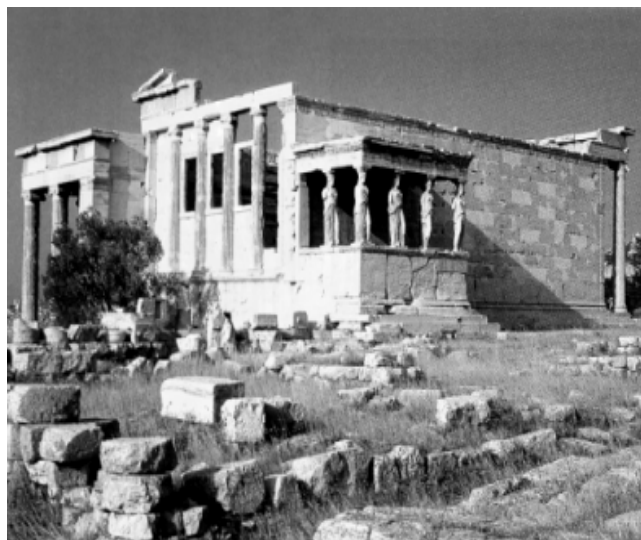

Join us on a specially priced package tour to Greece featuring a four-night cruise on a Louis Cruises' cruise ship. The package includes sightseeing to the most beautiful and famous attractions in Greece, as well as most meals. Whether in a remote mountain village, at a coastal fishing community, or in Constitution Square in the very heart of Athens, all are welcomed by the warm-hearted Greek people! One soon realizes that even the most reserved Greeks are willing to share the experience that is Greece- classic ancient ruins, bordered by secluded beaches, dotted by picturesque ports, and highlighted by white-washed villages perched atop impressive mountains!

While in Greece, we will be staying at the 4-star *Divani Palace* (or similar) in Athens. All rooms are air-conditioned and have a direct-dial telephone. The bar and restaurant compliment a pleasant stay. Wonderful accommodations for our Greek Holiday! From there, we board our cruise ship for a magnificent tour of the picturesque Greek Isles!

### OUR ITINERARY TO GREECE IS AS FOLLOWS:

**DAY 1: BOSTON-INTERMEDIATE CITY-ATHENS:** Depart Boston's Logan Airport on our overnight flight to Athens (*via an intermediate city*). Dinner and breakfast will be served in-flight. Headsets for our listening enjoyment will be provided. Beverage service is also available.

**DAY 2: ATHENS:** We will be transported from the airport in Athens to our hotel for check-in with a bank stop en route. The remainder of the afternoon is at our leisure to freshen-up and relax prior to our orientation meeting and "welcoming drink" before dinner. (D)

**DAY 3: ATHENS:** Following breakfast at the hotel, we are off on a morning sightseeing tour of Athens, featuring many of the most important sites in this ancient capital: the Temple of Zeus, Hadrian's Arch, the *Acropolis (including the famous Parthenon and Temple of Athena)*, the Acropolis Museum and the Presidential Palace. The afternoon is free for shopping, relaxation or touring on our own. Dinner is included this evening. The rest of the evening is at our leisure to enjoy the lively atmosphere of the tavernas and night clubs! (CB, D)

**DAY 4: MYKONOS:** Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we will board our motorcoach for the short drive to the port of Piraeus, where we will board our cruise ship. Depart Piraeus. Lunch onboard. Our first port-of-call is on the mountainous island of Mykonos, which is particularly known for its characteristic windmills and dazzling white-washed houses. Wander through the narrow, winding streets lined with trendy boutiques and friendly tavernas. Return to our ship for dinner and overnight. (CB, L, D) *NOTE: While on the cruise, shore excursions are optional and can be purchased from the ship directly.*

**DAY 5: KUSADASI & PATMOS:** Breakfast onboard. Our first stop on today's agenda is in Kusadasi, Turkey, with a chance to visit the nearby Greek, Roman and Byzantine excavations of Ephesus. Our next port-of-call is on the island of Patmos, where St. John the Divine is said to have written *The Revelation*. The 11<sup>th</sup> century monastery, known for its rare manuscript collection, is well worth a visit. Return to our ship for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**DAY 6: RHODES:** Breakfast onboard. Spend the entire day exploring the sun-drench island of Rhodes! Experience the historic Old City with its Medieval ramparts and palaces built by the Knights of St. John during the crusades. As an alternative, Rhodes' spectacular beaches and colorful shopping district are within easy walking distance of the harbor. Return to our ship for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**DAY 7: HERAKLION (CRETE) & SANTORINI:** Breakfast onboard. Morning port-of-call on Crete, the Greek island made famous in Homer's epic poems. Heraklion, the capital of Crete and its principal commercial port, is just three miles away from the fantastic ruins of the Palace of Knossos. The Archaeological Museum in Heraklion displays many of the treasures found during the excavations. Afternoon visit to Santorini, the "Black Pearl of the Aegean" and possibly the most beautiful of all the Greek islands. Return to our ship for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**DAY 8: PIRAEUS & ATHENS:** Breakfast onboard. Arrive in the port of Piraeus and disembark the ship. Continue-on to Athens for check-in at our hotel. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore Athens on our own, do some shopping, or just relax. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

**DAY 9: DELPHI:** After breakfast we will board our motorcoach for our full-day tour to Delphi on the slopes of Mount Parnassus. Here, we will walk on the ancient sacred way to the Temple of Apollo and then, on to the Museum where we can see, among many other archaeological treasures, the unique bronze statue of the Charioteer! Next, we will visit the Athenian Treasury and Castalia Springs. Lunch will be in Delphi. Return to Athens for hotel check-in. Dinner this evening is included. (CB, L, D)

**DAY 10: ATHENS-INTERMEDIATE CITY-BOSTON:** After breakfast, we will be transported to the airport where we will board our return flight to Boston (*via an intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service while in-flight. (CB)

**OUR TOUR OF GREECE INCLUDES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

- Special meet-and-greet service and assistance at Logan Airport by a Durgan Travel Service Representative.
- Porterage of luggage at the hotels and pier.
- Round trip regularly scheduled flights Boston-Intermediate City-Athens and return.
- 4-nights accommodations at the 4-star *Divani Palace* (or similar) in Athens. 4-night Greek Isles Cruise aboard a Louis Cruises' cruise ship. - A substantial continental breakfast (CB) and dinner (D) daily and 1 lunch (L). All meals while on cruise.
- Guided sightseeing as described in the itinerary. *Shore tours/excursions during the cruise portion of the tour are optional and at additional cost per person.*
- Full services of a local host/tour escort who will accompany the group on all sightseeing days, handle all airport transfers.
- Complimentary welcoming drink and orientation meeting our first night in Athens.
