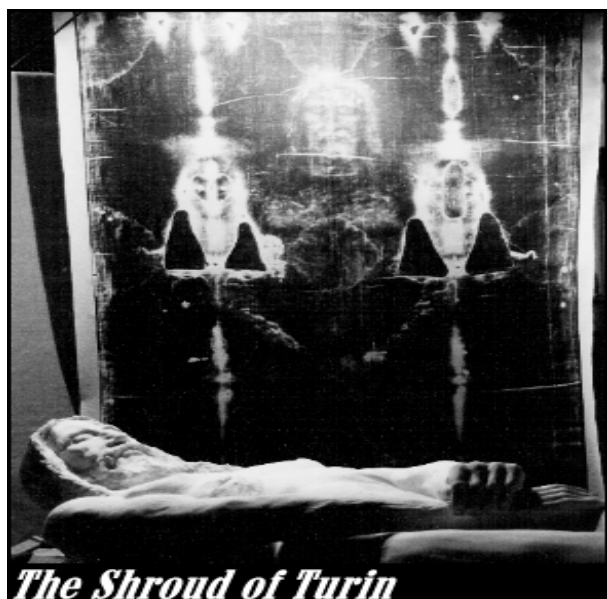

As announced by the Archdiocese of Turin, the Shroud of Turin will be available for public viewing for a brief 6-week period in April and May 2010. This is the first time the Shroud has been open to the public since 2002. Our 12-day/10-night tour will also include sightseeing in the Northern Lakes Region of Italy, in the Province of Tuscany, and in Rome. We will be staying at superior hotels in Stresa, Montecatini and Rome. Don't miss this chance to see one of the most venerated relics in Christendom – The Shroud of Turin! Sign-up today as space is limited, and on a first-come, first-served basis!

OUR SHROUD OF TURIN TOUR ITINERARY:

APR 25 – BOSTON-ROME-MILAN: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our transatlantic Alitalia flight to Milan (*via Rome*), with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight.

APR 26 – MILAN-STRESA: *Benvenuti in Italia!* Arrival at the airport in Milan where we will be met by our Tour Escort who will assist with our transfer. Board our private motorcoach for the drive north to Stresa. Arriving at Lake Maggiore, we will enjoy a lake cruise which includes a visit to Isola Bella and lunch on Isola Pescatori. Following our cruise, we will check-in at the 4-star *Hotel Milan Speranza au Lac* (or similar) in Stresa. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (L, D)

APR 27 – TURIN: Breakfast at our hotel. Full-day excursion to Turin which begins with a guided walking tour of many of the city's most historic and famous landmarks and culminates with our visit to the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist to view the Shroud of Turin! Lunch in Turin is on our own. Return to our hotel in Stresa for dinner and overnight. (CB, D)

APR 28 – LAKE COMO: Breakfast at our hotel. Board our motorcoach for the short ride to beautiful Lake Como where we will enjoy a refreshing morning cruise on the lake. In the afternoon, we will have plenty of free time to explore on our own or do some shopping-and-browsing. Lunch is on our own today. Return to our hotel in Stresa for dinner and overnight. (CB, D)

APR 29 – MILAN: Breakfast at our hotel. Full-day excursion to Milan, the leading commercial and industrial city in Italy. Milan is also the center of Italian haute couture and design. On our guided walking tour we will see many of the monuments to Milan's great success and industrial might. The height of today's tour will be a visit to the Chiesa Santa Maria delle Grazie to view Leonardo da Vinci masterpiece fresco – *The Last Supper!* Return to our hotel in Stresa for dinner and overnight. (CB, D)

APR 30 – STRESA-CHIANTI COUNTRY-MONTECATINI: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will head south driving through the beautiful Chianti Countryside. We will stop along our route for a wine tasting of the local vintage. Arriving in Montecatini, we will check-in at the 4-star *Hotel Puccini* (or similar). Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (CB, D)

MAY 1 – SIENA-SAN GIMIGNANO: Breakfast at our hotel. Morning drive to Siena, where our guide will lead us to Piazza del Campo, through the narrow streets, past Medieval towers and walls. One of the notable highlights of Siena is San Domenico, which holds relics of St. Catherine. On the way back to Montecatini, we visit San Gimignano, the charming Medieval hilltop town noteworthy for its many towers and its breathtaking views of the Tuscan landscape. Lunch in San Gimignano. Return to Montecatini for dinner and overnight at our hotel. (CB, L, D)

MAY 2 - FLORENCE: Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will be hosted on a guided walking tour of many of the most famous sites in "the birthplace of the Italian Renaissance" – Florence! Our tour ends at the Academia Museum to see Michelangelo's magnificent statue – *The David!* The afternoon is at leisure for independent sightseeing in Florence. Return to our hotel in Montecatini for dinner and overnight. (CB, D)

MAY 3 – MONTECATINI-ASSISI-ROME: Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we will drive south to Assisi for a guided walking tour including the Basilica of St. Francis. Continue-on to Rome where we will check-in at the first-class *Hotel Cilicia* (or similar). Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (CB, D)

MAY 4 – ANCIENT & MODERN ROME: Breakfast at our hotel. Full-day guided sightseeing in the Rome – "the Eternal City" – including many of the most famous and historic monuments of the Ancient and Modern Eras of Rome. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (CB, D)

MAY 5 – VATICAN CITY & ROME: Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will visit the four basilicas of Rome (*which complete the requirements for the plenary indulgence*) – St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City, followed by St. John Lateran, St. Mary Major, and St. Paul Outside the Walls in Rome. The remainder of the day is at leisure. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rome. (CB, D)

MAY 6 – ROME-BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the airport in Rome to board our non-stop Alitalia flight to Boston, with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. (CB)
