Inclusive of complete sightseeing package of Ireland and including expert tour guides, a full Irish breakfast each morning, and dinner each evening.

OUR TOUR OF IRELAND WITH GOLF ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~SHANNON: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our overnight flight to Ireland, with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight. *For more information on Ireland visit: www.discoverireland.ie*

DAY 2 – SHANNON~GALWAY: *Welcome to Ireland!* After our morning arrival at Shannon Airport, we will meet our Tour Escort, who will help us transfer to Galway. After departing the airport, we will visit the Cliffs of Moher, situated on the Atlantic Ocean, are one of Ireland's most spectacular sights. On a clear day, the Aran Islands are visible in Galway Bay as well as the valleys and hills of Connemara. The cliffs reach their highest point just north of O' Brien's Tower. After lunch (on our own), we'll travel to Galway for check-in at hotel, *Salthill Hotel* (or similar) and enjoy dinner and overnight. (D) Hotel website: <https://www.salthillhotel.com>

DAY 3 – CONNEMARA: After a delicious Irish breakfast, we will board our motorcoach to enjoy a tour of the Connemara region. We will visit Kylemore Abbey, stunningly located in the Kylemore Pass in Connemara. Mitchell Henry built the House in 1868, after having spent his honeymoon in the area. One of Kylemore Abbey's most famous features is its miniature cathedral, built in 1870 and known locally as the Gothic church. Today, the abbey is home to the Irish order of Benedictine nuns. After lunch (on our own), we'll return to Galway and enjoy the evening at leisure. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – GALWAY~DUBLIN: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will board our motorcoach, depart Galway and journey to Dublin. Upon arrival, we will check-in to our hotel, *Ashling Hotel* (or similar). Lunch on our own. Then we will enjoy a tour of the Guinness Storehouse at the Guinness Brewery, Europe's largest stout producing brewery in Europe. Opened in 1904, the Storehouse was an operational plant for fermenting and storing Guinness. Today it houses a very fine exhibition dedicated to the Guinness story. Visitors will discover what goes into the making a pint of Guinness - the ingredients, the brewing process, the time, the craft and the passion. The exhibition shows how the brew has been marketed and how it is today sold in over 150 countries. Return to the hotel for dinner and an evening at leisure. Overnight. DAY 5 – DAY OF GOLF: After breakfast, we will travel to The Island Golf Club to enjoy a day of golf (*tee fees included / rental of golf clubs, equipment and carts are an additional fee and must be reserved in advanced.*) Established in 1890, The Island Golf Club enjoys a unique setting bordered by sea on 3 sides. A classic links course set in a rugged terrain & nestled between the highest sand dunes along the east coast. About 30 minutes from Dublin City Centre, the Island is favorably located in the remote and tranquil Estuary of Donabate & Malahide. Enjoy panoramic views while enjoying lunch on our own at this picturesque golf club. After our golf match, we will return to our hotel and later enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight. (B, D)

DAY 6 – DUBLIN CITY: After breakfast this morning, enjoy a panoramic tour of Dublin City. Here you will discover the north and south side of the River Liffey. This area offers striking monuments such as the GPO (General Post Office) on the city main thoroughfare, O'Connell Street, or the Custom House along the quays, as well as the Phoenix Park, the largest public park in Europe. The south side appears more sophisticated with its vast Georgian squares, such as Merrion Square, where Oscar Wilde's House can still be found (today owned by an American College), its colorful doors, along with Grafton Street and its quality shops. Not so far from St. Stephen's Green, in Kildare St., you will see the house of Bram Stoker, the author of Dracula. Also in this part of the city is the medieval district where Dublin Castle and the two Anglican Cathedrals can be found. We will then visit Trinity College, the oldest university in Ireland and the famous Book of Kells exhibited in its library. This university was built to further the education of the ruling Anglo-Irish families, restrictions were imposed to prevent Catholic from attending courses until the restrictions were fully lifted in the 1970's. Trinity



however admitted women in 1902, earlier than most British universities. Within its walls, visitors will be able to admire Parliament Square and its 18th Century edifices. Trinity College has had many famous students such as Jonathan Swift and Samuel Beckett who later became a lecturer in French at the university. The inter-denominational Church is very much worth a visit. We will stop for lunch (on our own) and have a chance to enjoy the beautiful scenery. After lunch, we will then visit EPIC - The Irish Emigration Museum, a state-of-the-art interactive experience located in the beautiful vaults of the 1820 Custom House Quarter building in Dublin's Docklands, the original departure point for so many of



Ireland's emigrants. It will inspire and guide you on a journey to discover the stories of Irish emigration around the world, from early times to the modern day. At EPIC you can step through 20 themed galleries to find out why people left, see how they influenced the world they found, and experience the connection between their descendants and Ireland today. Immerse yourself in the stories of some of the most remarkable tales of sacrifice, endurance, adventure, and discovery the world has ever known. EPIC brings these amazing stories to life in a unique and spectacular way. Return to hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 7 – DUBLIN~CORK: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will say goodbye to Dublin and journey to Cork. En route, we will visit Kilkenny Castle. One of the most instantly recognized buildings in Ireland, Kilkenny Castle has been an important site since it was built by the Anglo-Normans in the 12th century. Due to major restoration works, the central block now includes a library, drawing room, and bedrooms decorated in 1830's splendor, as well as the beautiful Long Gallery. A suite of former servant's rooms is now the Butler Art Gallery, which mounts frequently changing exhibitions of contemporary art. The Parade Tower is the Castle's conference venue. We will enjoy lunch on our own and later continue onto Cork to check into our hotel, *Springfort Hall* (or similar). Dinner and overnight. (B, D) Hotel website: <https://www.springfort-hall.com>



DAY 8 – CORK~LIMERICK: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will travel to visit the Titanic Experience Cobh, located in Casement Square in the heart of Cobh Town. The Titanic Experience Cobh is at the original White Star Line Ticket Office, a building steeped in history dating back to the early 19th century and the departure point for many thousands of White Star Line passengers. Upon check-in you will receive your boarding card. Your boarding card will have the details of one of the 123 passengers who came to the White Star Line Ticket Office on Thursday April 11, 1912. These were the final passengers to join Titanic at her last port of call in Queenstown, Ireland. Your personal tour-guide will take you on a virtual journey to board the tenders and join Titanic for her maiden voyage to New York. Along this journey you will view the original pier also known as Heartbreak Pier, which was the last point of land contact for the Queenstown passengers. We will then visit the Midleton Distillery, where the true heart of Irish whiskey is born. Here we will take a journey through history and see the old kilns, mills and malting, water wheel and old warehouses. We will enjoy the "Jameson Experience" in Midleton, one of the top attractions in Cork, and end with a complimentary glass of Jameson whiskey. Enjoy a leisurely lunch on our own and maybe pick up an exclusive gift in the Jameson gift store. We will then continue onto Limerick and check into *Clayton Limerick* (or similar). DAY 9 – LIMERICK~SHANNON~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll transfer to the Shannon airport for our return flight to Boston. Meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, are available while in flight. (B)
