DAY 1 – JFK~ATHENS: Depart JFK Airport on our transatlantic non-stop flight to Athens with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight. **(PLEASE CONTACT US FOR FLIGHTS OUT OF BOSTON)**

DAY 2 – ATHENS: After landing at the airport in Athens, we will be met by our tour guide and transferred to our hotel, *Athens Key Hotel* (or similar). Welcome drink, dinner and overnight. (D) Hotel website: <https://www.athenskeyhotel.com/>

DAY 3 – MYKONOS: After breakfast this morning, we will check-out of our hotel and board the GEMINI to sail this morning from Athens to the quaint isle of Mykonos, called the “island of windmills”. We will join our tour escort on an orientation walking tour and will experience the waterfront lined with shops and cafes and then stroll the charming walkways through a maze of whitewashed buildings before returning to the ship for dinner and evening entertainment, then overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – SANTORINI: After breakfast today, we'll visit the island of Santorini, which is perhaps the most breathtaking of all the Greek Islands. The town of Thira, where white-washed houses, narrow streets, open-air cafes, and glittering boutiques cling to steep cliffs, is accessible by footpath, cable car, or mule. We will join our tour escort for an orientation walking tour and then choose an optional excursion or explore on your own. Again, we'll return to the ship for dinner and evening entertainment, then overnight. (B, D)

DAY 5 – RHODES: Breakfast on the ship. This morning, our cruise ship docks on the cosmopolitan island of Rhodes, where the legend of Colossus meets the glories of the Knights! Take an optional shore excursion or enjoy the day strolling in the medieval town, swim and shop! return to the ship for dinner and evening entertainment. Evening Sail. (B, D)

DAY 6 – KUSADASI & PATMOS: Breakfast on the ship. We will dock in Turkey and enjoy an included tour of Ephesus, the city of the Bible and one of the most extensive restorations still in progress with miles of ancient treasures. Ephesus was once a thriving port town of 250,000 people. Today, you can still see the spectacular excavations of the major streets in this ancient city, including the Agora, the Odeon, the Library, the marble-paved main Street, the Baths, Trajan's Fountain, the Residences of the Patricians, the Prytaneum, and Temple of Hadrian. The Great Theatre, built in the 4th century B.C., could accommodate 24,000 spectators, and it is famous even nowadays for its acoustics. This afternoon, the ship calls at the Isle of Patmos, home of the fortified monastery of St. John and the cave claimed to be where John received the Revelation. We will return back to our ship for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 7 – DISEMBARK~ CORINTH, MYCENAE & EPIDAUROS: Upon disembarkation from your cruise ship this morning, meet your guide and driver for a full-day excursion to the Peloponnese! The first stop will be the Corinth Canal, a true engineering miracle where thousands of Ships cross to enter the Aegean Sea from the Ionian Sea. The next stop is the Ancient city of Mycenae, which was first mentioned in the scripts of Homer in the Epic of Iliad and Odyssey. It had a dominant position in the development of Classical Greek culture. Witness the engineering and creative genius of the Lion Gate and the Treasury of Atreus. Our last stop will be at the ancient theater of Epidaurus. This colossal theater can accommodate up to 15,000 people. It has exceptional acoustics from every seat without the use of a microphone. It has beautiful symmetry and absolute beauty. Dinner and overnight in our Athens hotel. (B, D) Hotel website: <https://www.athenskeyhotel.com/>

DAY 8 – ATHENS & ACROPOLIS: After breakfast today, we will meet our guide and journey to the ancient Acropolis, where you will see the Propylaea, the Parthenon, and the Erectheum. We'll view the ruins of the Agora, the ancient marketplace and center of Athenian public life. You will visit the House of Parliament, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Olympic Stadium, and the Presidential Palace. Dinner and overnight in our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 9 – DELPHI: After breakfast today, we will meet our guide and drive up to Delphi, where the most important oracle of the Classical Greek world is situated and a significant site for worshiping God Apollo. Although before all that, it was a place of worship for Gaea (Mother Earth). Pythia was the sibyl priestess of Delphi; many generals from all over Greece would bring her offerings and seek her prophecies concerning critical strategic matters. Enjoy a nice local lunch before driving back to Athens for our last dinner and overnight in our hotel. (B, L, D)

DAY 10 – ATHENS~JFK: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll transfer to the airport in Athens to board our return non-stop flight to JFK with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. (B)
