DAY 1 – BOSTON~ATHENS: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport on our transatlantic flight to Athens (via intermediate stop) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight.

DAY 2 - ATHENS: After landing at the airport in Athens, we will be met by our tour guide and transferred to our hotel, *Athenaeum Palace* (or similar) our home for the next two nights. Afternoon at leisure. Welcome dinner and overnight. (D) *Hotel website: www.athenaeum-palace-luxury-suites.atticahotels.net/en/*

DAY 3 – ATHENS: This morning, we will have breakfast at our hotel, followed by a guided city tour of Athens, introducing us to the highlights of this bustling ancient capital, home to the world's first democracy. Pass by the Olympic Stadium, Syntagma Square, and the Arch of Hadrian. View the sixth century Temple of Zeus. See the classically inspired Old Royal Palace, home of the Hellenic Parliament, and drive through the Plaka district. Set off on a walking tour around the ancient Acropolis, site of the Parthenon, Temple of Athena Nike, and Erechtheion. After lunch on our own, we will take an excursion to Cape Sounion. Return to our hotel to refresh before our Greek dinner in Plaka old town! (B, D)

DAY 4 - MYKONOS: After breakfast at our hotel, we will check out of the hotel and head for the port, where we will travel by ferry to Mykonos, and follow our Tour Director on an orientation of Mykonos Town when you arrive. See the iconic windmills in Mykonos Town, built as early as the 16th century. View Little Venice, the charming neighborhood right along the Aegean Sea. Pass the Church of Panagia Paraportiani and admire its unique architecture. Check-in at *Hotel Petinos* (or similar) for dinner and overnight. (B, D) *Hotel website: www.petinoshotel.gr*

DAY 5 – MYKONOS: Following breakfast at the hotel, we'll transfer to the port for our Delos Island boat tour. Here we will discover the ancient ruins and sacred site on the island of Delos. With your guide, you will step back in time and explore the narrow city streets, and marvel at the impressive house of Dionysus and the exceptional mosaics, well-preserved marble columns, and wall paintings. See other monuments in the urban area, including the Theater of Delos. Take a walk along the main street to the market and the sanctuary zone. Here you'll find the Stoa of Phillippe, the Propylaia, the Colossus of the Naxians, and the Temple of Apollo. Overnight at hotel. (B)

DAY 6 – SANTORINI: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will say goodbye to Mykonos and ferry to Santorini. There, we will have time to discover the island's volcanic black sand beaches, cliff-lined shores, and stunning whitewashed architecture. We will have an orientation walking tour of Fira, capital of the island. Check into *Kalisti Hotel* (or similar) in Santorini for the next three nights. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, D) *Hotel website: www.kalistihotel.com/en/*

DAY 7 – SANTORINI: Following breakfast at the hotel this morning, we are off on a half-day guided tour of Santorini. We'll visit the prehistoric settlements that were unearthed during the archaeological excavations at Akrotiri. We will stop at the traditional settlement of OIA. Lunch is on our own today. Then we'll visit one of the famous Santorini Wineries and enjoy a wine tasting. Dinner on our own tonight. Overnight at the hotel this evening. (B)

DAY 8- SANTORINI: After breakfast, we will take a morning Catamaran cruise to the volcano and hot springs. Later, on board the catamaran, we will have a BBQ lunch. After heading back to Santorini mainland, we will enjoy the rest of the day at leisure and then dinner on our own. Overnight in our hotel (B, L)

DAY 9 – SANTORINI~ATHENS: Breakfast at the hotel this morning and check-out. We'll return back to Athens by ferry and check-in to our hotel, *Athenaeum Palace* (or similar), where we will enjoy the afternoon at leisure prior to enjoying a farewell dinner together. Overnight at the hotel this evening. (B, D) *Hotel website: www.athenaeum-palace-luxury-suites.atticahotels.net/en*

DAY 10: ATHENS~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will be transported to the airport in Athens where we will board our return flight to Logan Airport (via intermediate stop) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, in flight. (B)
