The present King's Wharf gives visitors plenty to do and see, what with the Bermuda Maritime Museum and the Bermuda Craft Market. King's Wharf is rich in naval history, with an endless array of activities for all ages, be it culture, water sports, good food, shopping, or kicking back at the beach. Other nearby activities include world-class golf courses, parasailing, scuba diving, and dolphin swims on the short list of things to do. Shop duty-free inside the Clocktower Mall or hop a ferry to anywhere. Or stroll through the Arts Centre to view the works of Bermuda's premier artists. King's Wharf has something for everyone. Sample typical island food (like fish chowder or cassava pie or one of the many local fish dishes made with wahoo, rockfish, mahi mahi, or spiny lobster), and stroll through the shops and museums of the Royal Naval Dockyard. Sail the clear waters of Hamilton Sound. Find quaint gems at the Bermuda Arts Center and Craft Market. If that's not enough, a snorkel park and water sport facility offers hours of activities to the adventuresome. Bermuda is a paradise for golfers, sailors, tennis fans, skin and scuba divers, lovers of every age, and just about anybody who enjoys tea rooms, English pubs, and great nightly entertainment.
