You will enjoy 3 nights in Athens where you will enjoy a guided tour of all that this ancient city has to offer. Also experience 2 nights in Mykonos!! Arrive by ferry to this picturesque island in the Aegean Sea with its windmills and 16th century villages. And finally spend 2 nights and 2 days on spectacular Santorini!! Explore the volcanic beaches and see the beautiful white washed cliff side villas. Our tour includes all accommodations and airport transfers as well as guided tours with expert English speaking guides.

OUR ITINERARY IS AS FOLLOWS:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~ATHENS: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport on our transatlantic flight to Athens (via intermediate stop) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight.

DAY 2 - ATHENS: After landing at the airport in Athens, we will be met by our tour guide and transferred to our hotel, the Athenaeum Palace (or similar) our home for the next two nights. Welcome dinner and overnight. (D) Hotel website: www.athenaeumpalace.com

DAY 3 – ATHENS: This morning, we will have breakfast at our hotel, followed by a guided tour of Athens, introducing us to the highlights of this bustling ancient capital, home to the world's first democracy. Pass by the Olympic Stadium, Syntagma Square, and the Arch of Hadrian. View the sixth century Temple of Zeus. See the classically inspired Old Royal Palace, home of the Hellenic Parliament, and drive through the Plaka district. Set off on a walking tour around the ancient Acropolis, site of the Parthenon, Temple of Athena Nike, and Erechtheion. Excursion to Cape Sounion. Lunch and dinner are on your own. Return to our hotel for time at leisure and overnight. (B)

DAY 4 - MYKONOS: After breakfast at our hotel, we will check out of the hotel and head for the port, where we will travel by ferry to Mykonos, and follow our Tour Director on an orientation of Mykonos Town when you arrive. See the iconic windmills in Mykonos Town, built as early as the 16th century. View Little Venice, the charming neighborhood right along the Aegean Sea. Pass the Church of Panagia Paraportiani and admire its unique architecture. Lunch is on our own. Finally, we'll check in at our hotel (Hotel Petinos or similar) for dinner and overnight. DAY 5 – MYKONOS: Following breakfast at the hotel, we will have a special treat today- the highlight of any tour: a cooking demonstration and a lunch package! The rest of the day (and night) are at leisure to enjoy the beautiful island and explore dinner options on your own. Overnight at our hotel. (B, L)

DAY 6 – SANTORINI: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will say goodbye to Mykonos and ferry to Santorini. There, we will have time to discover the island's volcanic black sand beaches, cliff-lined shores, and stunning whitewashed architecture and have a leisurely lunch on our own.. Check in to our hotel for the next two nights, the Hotel Rose Bay (or similar). Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, D) Hotel website:

DAY 7 – SANTORINI: Following breakfast at the hotel this morning, we are off on a half-day guided tour of Santorini. Visit the prehistoric settlements that were unearthed during the archaeological excavations at Akrotiri. Ride to the top of Mount Profitis Ilias for panoramic views of the whole island. Stop in the small, picturesque village of Pyrgos where you can enjoy a lunch on our own. Overnight at the hotel this evening. (B)

DAY 8 – SANTORINI~ATHENS: Breakfast at the hotel this morning, before we return by ferry to Athens, where we will relax and enjoy a lunch on our own prior to enjoying a farewell dinner together. Overnight at the hotel, the Athenaeum Palace (or similar) this evening. (B, D)

Greece COVID Requirements

Starting December 19, travelers 5 years and older are required to present a negative COVID-19 PCR test taken within 72 hours of departure or a rapid antigen test taken within 24 hours of arrival to Greece. This testing requirement will apply regardless of vaccination status or method of entry to Greece. In addition, travelers must complete a [Passenger Locator Form \(PLF\)](https://travel.gov.gr/#/) before arriving in Greece.
