Malta is a favorite tourist destination, due to its warm Mediterranean climate, numerous recreational areas, and varied architectural and historical monuments, including seven UNESCO World Heritage Sites, including some of the oldest free-standing structures in the world. OUR 16-DAY/14-NIGHT MALTA SUPER SPECIAL ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE CITY~MALTA: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our transatlantic flight to the island of Malta (via intermediate city) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight.

DAY 2 – THE ISLAND OF MALTA: Upon arrival at Malta International Airport, we will meet our Tour Escort, who will help us transfer to our hotel. The rest of the afternoon is free to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (D)

DAY 3 – THE SOUTH OF MALTA: After breakfast at our hotel, we're off on a full-day tour, visiting the south of Malta. The excursion includes visits to Tarxien Temples, the Blue Grotto (boat ride not included), Marsaxlokk fishing village, and Ghar Dalam prehistoric caves. We'll enjoy a 3-course lunch during our tour. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 4 – MALTA: After breakfast, we'll enjoy a free day of leisure to explore the island. We can do some shopping and browsing at the local bazaars, experience the beautiful beaches, do some individual sightseeing, or just relax. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 5 – VALLETTA: After breakfast, we will visit the capital city of Valletta, named the European Capital of Culture for 2018. The excursion includes visits to the Upper Barrakka Gardens, St. John's Co-Cathedral, which houses a Caravaggio masterpiece (*The Beheading of St. John*), Grandmasters' Palace, and the Malta Experience, an audiovisual show depicting 5000 years of Maltese history. We'll enjoy another 3-course lunch in Valletta. Dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 – MALTA: After breakfast, we'll enjoy a free day of leisure to continue discovering this exotic island. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 7 – GOZO: After breakfast, we will take a full-day tour to Gozo, Malta's sister island. After a 20-minute ferry crossing, one immediately notices that, although both islands are similar in history and development, Gozo offers a unique setting due to its traditional character. Our guided tour in Gozo begins with a visit of the Megalithic Temples of Ggantija followed by the Old Citadel in Victoria and the Calypso Cave. We'll then visit Xlendi Bay and Dwejra, where we can admire the Inland Sea (boat ride not included). We'll enjoy another 3-course lunch today as well. We'll take a short return ferry to Malta. Dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAYS 8 & 9 – MALTA: After breakfast, we'll enjoy another free day of leisure. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 10 – MDINA: After breakfast, we will take a full-day tour of Mdina tour (top photo), first visiting the old capital city of Mdina (including entrance to the Cathedral), then the St. Catald Catacombs in Rabat, Domus Romana, Ta Qali Crafts village, Dingli Cliffs, Mosta Dome, and San Anton Botanic Gardens. We'll enjoy another 3-course lunch. Dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAYS 11 & 12 – MALTA: After breakfast, we'll enjoy another free day of leisure. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 13 – SENGLEA~COSPICUA~VITTORIOSA: After breakfast, we'll take a full-day tour of three beautiful cities: Senglea, Cospicua, and Vittoriosa, including St. Lawrence Church and the Inquisitors' Palace. We will travel to Sliema to board a ferry for a 90-minute harbor cruise around the ports of Valletta. And we'll enjoy another 3-course lunch in a local restaurant! Dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAYS 14 & 15 – MALTA: After breakfast, we'll enjoy another free day of leisure. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 16 – MALTA~INTERMEDIATE CITY~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to Malta International Airport to board our return flight to Boston (*via intermediate city*) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in flight. (B)
