3	San Juan, Puerto Rico - San Juan is one of the world's top cruise ship destinations, with most of the pleasure boats docking at the port by the old town. As recently as the 1970s, Old San Juan (Viejo San Juan) was a reminder of better times, a run-down collection of Spanish colonial relics, in little better shape than the collapsed empire that constructed them. Now, however, after extensive and careful restoration, this seven-block-square area is considered one of the best-kept troves of Spanish colonial architecture and has become a World Heritage Site. You just have to stop off at San Juan, with its steep, narrow streets distinctively cobbled with smooth, iridescent bricks known as <i>adoquines</i> , originally used as ballast in ships, and feature buildings – some of the oldest in the Western hemisphere – with bright pastel facades and wrought-iron balconies abloom with plants and flowers.	5:00 pm	1:00 am
4	Charlotte Amalie, St. Thomas - A cruise to the U.S. Virgin Islands means entering the small constellation of St. Thomas, St. Croix and St. John. If you travel with an MSC cruise ship, you will disembark at Charlotte Amalie, the capital with streets and places still bearing Danish names. While you enjoy your holiday in the Antilles, you should take a pleasant stroll through the city and discover its gems. From Government Hill, head to Lille Tarné Gade, which means the street of the little tower in Danish: with its 99 steps, it is probably the most important stepped street of those built by the Danish from bricks used by European ships as ballast. At the top of the climb (actually, there are 103 steps!), you will find to have only reached the base of Blackbeard's Castle, today a restaurant and an inn. Among the pirates to have lived here, it seems there was the terrible Edward Teach, a.k.a. Blackbeard, who inspected the bays of the island from the castle's observation tower, which is over 300 years old. The view that opens from this spot explains the	7:00 am	7:00 pm

5	Philipsburg, St. Maarten - During your cruise in the Caribbean Sea, after disembarking from your cruise ship in the Dutch port of Philipsburg and visiting the Court House, the heart of the city (a white and blue building dating to 1793 that now serves as the Post Office), don't miss out on an excursion to the French side of the island. Marigot, the capital of Saint Martin located on the island's western coast, is protected by the great lagoon of Simpson Bay. It has retained the atmosphere of late 17th century, when it was founded. It is worth your while to visit its historical centre, which is crowded with wooden houses dotted with delightful shops. Next, treat yourself to an excursion to Fort St. Louis, built on a hill on the orders of Louis XVI. From here, you can enjoy a stupendous view of Marigot Bay and its beautiful yacht club with the majestic docked luxury yachts.	7:00 am	2:00 pm

7	Nassau, Bahamas – Nassau occupies the eastern portion of the island of New Providence and is linked by a charming bridge with the neighboring Paradise Island, where Atlantis Waterscape is located. The largest open-air aquarium in the world has over 100 different species of colorful tropical fish. In Nassau, you can interact with dolphins and go on excursions to neighboring islands in motorboats. The historical center of Nassau boasts charming colonial-style buildings and numerous pastel-colored wooden shops that alternate with Georgian-style structures. However, to get a taste of the local style of living, take a trip to Cable Beach. Located just 3 miles west of the city, you will be able to admire the Bahamian Riviera and its fantastic colors: golden sand and lively nightlife. In addition to the casinos, which are very popular with gamblers, one of the most appealing characteristics of a vacation in Nassau is the possibility to do some low-cost shopping.	12:00 pm	7:00 pm
