3	Ocho Rios, Jamaica - The white buildings of Ocho Rios appear unexpectedly from lush vegetation covering the coast. On Main Street, you will be able to shop or pass your day on solid ground. We suggest you try the many outdoor activities offered on its rivers, such as kayaking and tubing. Another must-see attraction are the waterfalls along the Dunn River: almost 200 meters of natural steps over which the water flows to then fall about 60 meters directly into the sea. These enchanting waterfalls can be climbed via stairs set on either side.	9:00A	5:00P
4	George Town, Cayman Islands - The Cayman Islands are located in the British West Indies and George Town, the capital of the Cayman Islands situated on Grand Cayman. Visitors never tire of the wide open blue skies and lush green vegetation that forms a perfect backdrop for the brightly colored tropical flowers that are native to the island. The world-famous Seven Mile Beach (in reality only 5.5 miles!) is often hailed as 'the loveliest beach in the Caribbean.' Join an exciting 'wreck & reef' snorkeling experience, interact with friendly stingrays or stay above water in a catamaran or glass-bottomed boat you cannot fail to be seduced by what these waters have to offer.	8:00A	4:00P
5	Cozumel, Mexico - Measuring just 28 miles long by 10 miles wide, Cozumel is renowned for its dazzling white sand beaches and the clarity of the Caribbean ocean in which it lies. Whether in a rugged off-road jeep or a special clear-bottomed kayak, treat yourself to new experiences. Cruise passengers that prefer dry land can tour the magnificent Mayan ruins in the walled city of Tulum. Finally for a dose of pure fun, join our ATV (all-terrain vehicle) jungle adventure. Families won't want to miss a trip to X-Caret, Cancun's largest natural adventure park. With an aquarium, gardens, butterfly pavilion, monkey park, deer shelter, turtles and much more, this stop makes for a tremendous day out.	10:00A	6:00P

6	Costa Maya - Puerto Costa Maya is out of sight north of of Mahahual, on cruise-ship days the village springs to life with souvenir stands and jet-ski rentals along the slick seafront promenade, an extremely miniature version of Playa del Carmen. On an MSC cruise you will typically stay around Mahahual, while divers and anglers head south to Xcalak. If you stop for only one ancient site in the Río Bec area, Kohunlich is your best excursion choice. The ruins, seldom visited by anyone other than enormous butterflies and wild parrots, are beautifully situated, peering out above the treetops. The buildings date from the late pre-Classic to the Classic periods (100–900 AD) and the majority are in the Río Bec architectural style. Foliage has reclaimed most of them, except for the Templo de los Mascarones, which is named after the five 2m-high stucco masks that decorate its facade. Disturbing enough now, these wide-eyed, open-mouthed images of the sun god, Kinich Ahau, once stared out from a background of smooth, bright-red-painted stucco. Also look for an elite residential area called the 27 Escalones, worth the detour to see the great views over the jungle canopy from the cliff edge on which it is built. Set in a drier area with sparse trees, these two neighbouring ruins are an interesting contrast to Kohunlich. Kinichná's hulking pyramid, built in metre-high stones, layer upon layer by successive leaders, barely clears the trees, but you can look over the surrounding terrain (and spot a glimpse of the Dzibanché ancient Maya archaeological site), now broken into farmland.	8:00A	5:00P
