OUR SOUTH AFRICA TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE STOP~JOHANNESBURG: Depart Logan International Airport on an overnight flight to Johannesburg, South Africa (via intermediate city) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight.

DAY 2 –JOHANNESBURG: On arrival at O.R. Tambo International Airport, guests will be met by our tour representative who will assist you to the transfer vehicle to the hotel. Check into the Peermont Mondior at Emperors Palace Hotel. Tonight, guests will enjoy a delicious dinner at the hotel or the Emperors Palace Casino and Entertainment Centre. DAY 3 –JOHANNESBURG: Guests will enjoy a delicious breakfast at the hotel before departing on a full day tour of Johannesburg. Experience the thrills and pace of this African heartbeat by visiting the sites, indulging in the sounds and taking in the flavors of this stirring city. Highlights include the Apartheid Museum, the Carlton Centre and the SAB World of Beer. The Apartheid Museum is an extraordinarily powerful museum, certain to become one of Johannesburg's most important tourist attractions, has become an obligatory stop for tourists and residents alike. If you want a bird's-eye view of Johannesburg, the 50-story Carlton Centre is the place to go. Visitors to the centre can enjoy a panoramic view of the City of Gold from the Top of Africa, as the topmost floor of the building is known. The tallest building in Africa and once the tallest building in the southern hemisphere, the Carlton Centre stands 223 m high – about 40 m shy of featuring on the world's top 100 skyscrapers list. We'll then take a tour of the SAB World of Beer, and you'll quickly discover why it has twice been named the number one tourist attraction in South Africa. This intriguing, entertaining and interactive journey explores the rich history of beer, uncovering the important role beer has played culturally, socially and economically across space and time. This multi-sensory, fun and interactive beer experience is a liquid adventure like no other. With priceless memorabilia and a fully recreated historical pub, there's nowhere else that you can experience beer the truly South African way. Included is the following: Tour guide, One half way beer, Souvenir glass, Two drink vouchers redeemable in The Tap Room, Bar snacks after the tour. Lunch (on own). Afterwards, guests will make their way back to the hotel to enjoy the afternoon at their leisure. Tonight, guests will enjoy a delicious dinner at the hotel or the Emperors Palace Casino and Entertainment Centre. Overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 –JOHANNESBURG-MAKALALI: Following breakfast, guests will check-out and transfer back to O.R. Tambo International Airport for their flight to Hoedspruit Airport. Upon arrival at Hoedspruit Airport guests will be met by a guide and will be transferred to Makalali Private

Game Lodge, where we'll check in and then depart on an afternoon game activity after tea/coffee in the camp. Guests will enjoy dinner at the camp. (B, D) Hotel website: <https://aha.co.za/makalali/>

DAY 5- MAKALALI PRIVATE GAME LODGE: The day starts with an early wake-up call between 5 am and 5:30 am. Tea, coffee and rusks are enjoyed together before heading out at first light on our morning game drive. Since this is a Big Five reserve, seeing lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and buffalo is possible over a two-day safari in Makalali Private Game Reserve. While seeing big game is always exhilarating, there are many other smaller species that are also captivating, and birding enthusiasts will be delighted at numerous species of birds recorded on the reserve. Halfway through the game drive, there's a stop for hot drinks and snacks, before returning to the lodge at around 9am for a full breakfast. Guests may spend the rest of the morning at their leisure. At around 3:30 pm, everyone gathers for a decadent high tea, before heading out with your ranger and tracker for the afternoon game drive through the reserve. En route, you'll stop for a sundowner drink and will have a chance to stretch your legs as you watch the sun set over the distant peaks of the Drakensberg Mountains. As darkness falls, the nocturnal animals of the bush come out. The skilled tracker will scan the landscape using a spotlight, which illuminates animals' eyes. Arrival is at the lodge is usually around 7 pm, allowing time to freshen up before enjoying a sumptuous dinner. Overnight. (B, D)

DAY 6 – HOEDSPRUIT-JOHANNESBURG: Guests will enjoy a delicious full breakfast at the lodge before departing. After completing check out formalities, guests will continue on to the Hoedspruit Airport for their flight to Johannesburg. On arrival at O.R. Tambo International Airport, guests will be met by a tour representative who will assist you to the transfer vehicle to the hotel, PeerMont Mondior at Emperors Palace Hotel. DAY 7 – JOHANNESBURG- LIVINGSTONE: After breakfast, guests will check out and will be transferred to the airport for their flight to Livingstone. Upon arrival in Livingstone, guests will be met and transferred by road to the David Livingstone Safari Lodge. Guests check in at their lodge and have some time to freshen up before departing on their sunset cruise on the Lady Livingstone, a 144-foot three-decker river cruiser. It offers a truly once-in-a-lifetime experience. The Sunset Cruise which takes 2 good romantic hours of enjoying the spectacular view of the Sun set while hearing the gentle sound of the Zambezi River and enjoying a drink or two with some fine snacks. The Cruise on the Zambezi River takes you along the Mosi O Tunya National Park with the intention of seeing some of our wildlife. This is a great time to hear the sound of a Hippo or from time to time see Elephants as they cross the river or feed on one of the islands in the river. Return to the hotel. Overnight. DAY 8 – LIVINGSTONE: Enjoy breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast you will tour Victoria Falls. On the opposite cliff, facing the falls, you can take a well-marked and paved walk through the rain forests. Every so often the path will open out into a clearing for a view of the falls. Further along this path is the Knife Edge Bridge which affords an impressive panorama depending on the time of year. Although less can be seen of the width of the falls during the wet season, the intense spray provides welcome relief from the heat, but don't carry anything you don't want to get wet! Please note that water levels on the Zambian side is lower than on the Zimbabwe side from July to December. The balance of the day is at leisure. Overnight. (B)

DAY 9 –LIVINGSTONE-CHOBE: After breakfast, complete check out formalities and transfer by road from Livingstone to Chobe – Botswana. Upon arrival in Chobe check in at Cresta Mowana Safari Lodge. Built around a grand 800-year-old baobab tree, which still stands proudly preserved in its centre, Cresta Mowana Safari Lodge is a place where luxury exists in harmony with nature. This tranquil safari lodge in the small town of Kasane, Botswana, is your chance to experience true comfort right on the banks of the mighty Chobe River. The lodge stands near the Sedudu Gate entrance to the Chobe National Park. Through this gate guests will enter a land where massive herds of elephants, antelope, giraffe, zebra, lion and leopard roam free. The Chobe River is a hub for activities, including bird-watching from a mokoro and a canoe trail which winds its way along the river. Those looking for a more leisurely activity can take to the 9-hole golf course for a round of golf. Each of the 110 Luxury Rooms and 4 Suites boasts a view of the Chobe River and is decorated to create a natural ambience. Guests gather at the Serondella restaurant and Savuti cocktail bar to look out on to the Chobe River and the Namibian floodplains and witness the abundant wildlife gathering at twilight. We'll enjoy an afternoon game cruise on the Chobe River. Afterwards you will return to the lodge and have some time to freshen up before dinner is served at the lodge. Overnight. DAY 10 & 11 – CHOBE: Today you will wake up early to enjoy a crisp and refreshing early morning game drive in the park. With the meandering Chobe river on its border, the Chobe National Park has some of the finest game viewing in Africa and one of the biggest concentrations of elephants in Africa. It is also notable for huge herds of buffalo and zebras, lechwe, Chobe bushbuck and puku antelope can also be seen. Where there are buffalo, lions are never far away and there is a good chance of seeing large prides who laze around in the shade all day and only yawn themselves awake at dusk. Hyena and leopard also hunt at night while cheetahs are diurnal predators. Chobe is rich in bird life with the Pel's Fishing owl a favorite for bird watchers and the peculiar strangely beaked African skimmer another specialty. African fish eagles are common and their distinctive cry is as evocative of the African wilderness as the roar of the lion. Afterwards breakfast will be served at the lodge. After breakfast you will have the day at leisure to laze by the pool or simply relax around the lodge's common areas. Lunch will also be enjoyed at the lodge. We'll have an afternoon game drive through Chobe National Park or River Safari on the Chobe River. Afterwards you will return to the lodge and have some time to freshen up before dinner is served. (B, L, D)

DAY 12 – CHOBE-CAPE TOWN: Today you will wake up early to enjoy a crisp and refreshing early morning game drive in the park (subject to your flight departure times from lodge). Breakfast will be served at the lodge prior to departure. Complete the check-out procedure and depart from Chobe by road and transfer to the Livingstone Airport for your flight to Johannesburg to connect with your flight to Cape Town. On arrival at Cape Town International Airport, guests will be met by your tour representative and transferred to the hotel. One of the world's most picturesque tourist destinations and most beautiful cities in the world, Cape Town is situated amidst majestic mountains and is surrounded by pristine white beaches. Often called the 'cosmopolitan hub of Africa', it is home to a rich cultural and historical heritage, vibrant restaurants and nightlife and a multitude of activities - from extreme sports to leisurely scenic cruises and world-class shopping.

On arrival at Cape Town International Airport, guests will be met by your tour representative who will assist the guests to their touring vehicle for a Cape Town orientation tour. Highlights of this half-day tour include a visit up Table Mountain on the cableway, Malay Quarter, city centre and Company Gardens and time permitting the Castle of Good Hope. Photographic opportunities of Table Mountain present from Table Bay and the Cape Town Diamond Works. Afterwards, guests will be transferred to their hotel, Harbour Bridge Hotel & Suites, where they will spend the rest of the evening at their leisure. DAY 13 – CAPE POINT: Guests will enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing on their Cape Point full-day tour. Cape Town is set on a spectacular mountainous peninsula jutting into the southern oceans. This full day tour is an ideal way to see the highlights and appreciate the surrounding natural beauty. You'll travel along the Atlantic seaboard with its gorgeous white beaches and rugged mountains to Hout Bay. If open, you'll continue on Chapman's Peak Drive, renowned as one of the most stunning roadways in the world. You'll visit the Cape Point Nature Reserve, the tip of the Cape Peninsula that has captivated travelers for centuries with its dramatic scenery and fascinating history. The return journey to Cape Town takes you along False Bay coast with the option of visiting the colony of rare African Penguins at Boulders Beach. You'll pass through the naval village of Simon's Town, Fish Hoek, Kalk Bay and Muizenberg. Afterwards continue to Simon's Town where you will enjoy lunch at The Black Marlin restaurant. After lunch we'll visit Boulders Beach, a sheltered beach made up of inlets between granite boulders, from which the name originated. It is located in the Cape Peninsula near Simon's Town towards Cape Point near Cape Town in the Western Cape province of South Africa. It is also commonly known as Boulders Bay. It is a popular tourist stop because of a colony of African Penguins which settled there in 1982. Boulders Beach forms part of the Table Mountain National Park. Although set in the midst of a residential area, it is one of the few sites where this vulnerable bird can be observed at close range, wandering freely in a protected natural environment. From just two breeding pairs in 1982, the penguin colony has grown to about 3000. After returning to the hotel you will have the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Tonight, guests will enjoy a 3-course dinner at Hussar Grill in Camps Bay. Overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 14 – THE CAPE WINELANDS: Guests will enjoy a delicious breakfast before departing for the Cape Winelands region, the source of many legendary Cape wines, the produce of row upon row of grapevines, many of which were first planted hundreds of years ago. Its classic Cape-Dutch homesteads, mountainous surrounds, grand heritage and sumptuous restaurants have earned the Cape Winelands the right to call itself South Africa's culinary capital. Apart from a wide choice of wine estate cellars lined with top-class wines, visitors will discover a variety of locally produced cheeses, olives, export-quality fruit and organic produce to sample and buy. We'll visit Spier Winery for a tasting. Spier prides itself on its award-winning wines and long rich history. The history of the farm can be traced back to 1692 when the first owner was granted the land by Simon van Der Stel, the Governor of the Cape Colony. The farm has some of the best-preserved buildings in South Africa built during the colonial era under Dutch and British rule. Today Spier is an award-winning winery with a hotel and a restaurant which serves food that is made with ingredients that have been grown on the farm or on nearby farms. We'll also explore Stellenbosch. Known worldwide for its quality wines and the spectacular beauty of the surroundings Stellenbosch is home to one of the most prestigious old Wine Regions in the world. Visitors will be mesmerized by breathtaking scenery and warm South African hospitality. Here one can enjoy the juice of the vine in an awe inspiring historic setting. Founded in 1679, Stellenbosch is the oldest town in South Africa next to Cape Town. Walking through the streets of Stellenbosch, one can almost feel the history, as if strolling in days of old. The town is packed with many historic buildings dating back to the early 1700's. Guests will enjoy a delicious lunch in Stellenbosch before departing for the Waterford Estate. At Waterford, the chocolate and wine tasting is a unique flavor experience. Kevin Arnold and Chocolatier Richard von Geusau have created a series of dark and milk chocolates that, when paired with our Shiraz, Cabernet Sauvignon and Natural Sweet wines give you totally unique taste sensation. Guests will also taste selected Waterford Estate Wines, Kevin Arnold Shiraz and Pecan Stream Wines. After returning to the hotel you will have the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 15 – CAPE TOWN: Guests will enjoy breakfast at the hotel. Spend your day at leisure relaxing on the beach, or perhaps join the optional Robben Island Tour or a Township Tour. Guests will be transferred to Quay 4 Restaurant Upstairs for a delicious dinner. Overnight. (B, L, D)
