#### **OUR ADRIATIC COAST OF ITALY TOUR ITINERARY:**

**DAY 1 – BOSTON~ROME~BOLOGNA:** Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our transatlantic Alitalia flight to Bologna (*via Rome*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in-flight.

**DAY 2 – BOLOGNA~RIMINI:** "Benvenuti in Italia!" Arrival at Guglielmo Marconi Airport in Bologna where we will be met by our Tour Escort who will assist with our transfer. Board our private motorcoach for the drive to the beach resort of Rimini on the beautiful Adriatic Coast. Check-in at the *Hotel Corallo* (or similar) located on the beach in Rimini. The remainder of the day is at leisure to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (D) *Hotel website: www.hotelcorallorimini.com*

**DAY 3 – REPUBLIC OF SAN MARINO:** Breakfast at our hotel. Board our motorcoach for a morning drive to the 3<sup>rd</sup> smallest country in Europe, officially known as "The Most Serene Republic of San Marino". On our guided tour, we will see the Gothic Palazzo Pubblico, the colorful Fortress Guards at the Piazza della Liberta, the 14<sup>th</sup> century Church of San Francesco, the Palazzo dei Valloni, the Neo-Classical Basilica of San Marino and many of San Marino's most historic sites. Our tour ends at the Fortress of Mount Titano, which offers tremendous panoramic views of the surrounding countryside and the Adriatic Sea. Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

**DAY 4 – BOLOGNA:** Breakfast at our hotel. Today's excursion takes us to one of Italy's most historic, yet modern centers – Bologna! Bologna, one of the oldest cities in Italy, lies at the foot of the Apennine Mountains and has long been known for its graceful architecture, outstanding universities, and mouth-watering cuisine. Our local guided will acquaint us with the area around the Main Square, including the Church of San Petronio (*with its unfinished façade*), the fantastic Statue of Neptune of Giambolognas, the famous Middle Age towers, Torre Garisenda, Torre Asinelli, and many other important landmarks. Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

**DAY 5 – MODENA:** Breakfast at our hotel. Today, we will visit the idyllic town of Modena which is probably most famous as "the home of Ferrari motorcars", but in truth is an historic center which reflects the culture and life of the surrounding area. Our local guide will takes us on an informative walking tour of many of Modena's most historic venues, including the 12<sup>th</sup> century Romanesque Cathedral (*declared by UNESCO to be among 500 masterpieces worldwide*), the impressive Municipal Palace, the imposing Palazzo Ducale, and much more! As well as the birthplace of Ferrari, Modena also is proud to call itself home to Luciano Pavarotti and Balsamic vinegar! Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

**DAY 6 – FERRARA~RAVENNA:** Breakfast at our hotel. Our full-day of sightseeing begins in Ferrara, which is situated on a broad plain north of Rimini. Ferrara still preserves its Renaissance-era atmosphere when it was the seat of the court of the powerful Este family. With our local guide, we will explore Ferrara's twisting, medieval cobblestone streets, visit the magnificent Cathedral with its towering Gothic façade, and – best of all – the Castello Estense, a castle straight out of the storybooks with a moat, drawbridges and towers! Next on our agenda is a visit to the former Byzantine center of Ravenna. The city is particularly renowned for its mosaics, artworks and architecture of the Byzantine period (6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> century AD) of which our guide will introduce to many outstanding examples. Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

**DAY 7 – FLORENCE:** Breakfast at our hotel: This morning, our motorcoach will head due west to the city which was the "birthplace of the Italian Renaissance" – Florence! Considered one of the most beautiful cities in Italy – and maybe in the world – Florence is known far-and-wide for its fabulous food, monumental architecture, and overpowering art. Among the many "treasures" of Florence that our guide will introduce us to, will be the world-famous Duomo di Santa Maria del Fiore (*cathedral*) with its Brunelleschi-designed cupola, Giotto's Bell Tower, and the 14<sup>th</sup> century bronze doors of the Baptistery. Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (BB, D)

**DAY 8 – RIMINI:** Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will be hosted on a guided walking tour of the town of Rimini, starting with the Arch of Augustus which dates from early roman times. In the historic city center, around the main square – Piazza Cavour – we will see the Palazzo della Podesta, the Palazzo Arengo, the Fish Market and the Fontana della Pigna. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to explore on our own, shop-and-browse, or simply relax. Dinner at our hotel this evening. Overnight. (BB, D)

**DAY 9 – RIMINI~BOLOGNA~ROME~BOSTON:** After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to Guglielmo Marconi Airport in Bologna to board our return flight to Boston (*via Rome*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in-flight. (BB)
