OUR 9-DAY/7-NIGHT ALPINE ADVENTURE TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE CITY~MUNICH: Depart Boston's Logan Airport on our transatlantic flight to Munich (*via intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight.

DAY 2 – MUNICH~INNSBRUCK: Upon arrival in Munich, we will meet our Tour Escort, who will help us transfer to our hotel in Innsbruck, which will be our base for the next seven nights. We will enjoy a welcome dinner at the hotel to celebrate our arrival. (D)

DAY 3 – INNSBRUCK~WATTENS: After breakfast at the hotel, we will tour the old town of Innsbruck, including all the major sights such as the famous Golden Roof of the Bergisel Stadium (site of the Olympic ski jump). Innsbruck's beautiful town center has historic buildings dating back 800 years. The city, besides being known for hosting the 1964 and 1976 Winter Olympics, is extremely scenic, situated in the Inn Valley between two dramatic mountain chains. Later we'll drive to Wattens, where we will explore the home of Swarovski Crystal. Founded in 1895 by Daniel Swarovski, whose vision was to bring joy to people through crystal, the company has grown to become a leading producer of cut crystal, from premium jewelry to decorative objectives and lighting. We will return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – NEUSCHWANSTEIN CASTLE (FÜSSEN)~OBERAMMERGAU: After breakfast, we focus on Germany's most famous castle – Neuschwanstein (*top picture*). We drive via the Fernpass to Füssen to reach Hohenschwangau and the fairytale castle commissioned by King Ludwig II as a retreat. Opened to the public in 1886, it was the inspiration for Disneyland's Sleeping Beauty Castle. After a visit of the castle, we continue on to Oberammergau – the Passion Play town. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 5 – MUNICH CITY TOUR WITH OKTOBERFEST: After breakfast, one of the highlights of our trip – Munich – awaits us today! We start with a guided walking tour through Munich, including all the main sights. The city derives its name from the Benedictine monks who founded it in 1158. Marienplatz is a large open square in the city's center and houses both the Old and New Town Halls. Here you can also see three gates still remaining from the medieval fortifications. The city also has many old churches, royal avenues, and squares. Afterwards we drive to the Theresien Wiese, where we have organized tables for you in one of the giant Oktoberfest beer tents. (*NOTE: Oktoberfest activities are only available during the last two weeks in September. Tours during other points in the year will include additional sightseeing in Munich.*) Dinner is on our own this evening. Overnight. (B, L)

DAY 6 – DOLOMITE MOUNTAINS: After breakfast, today's journey takes us south over Europe's highest road-bridge, across the Brenner Pass and into Italy to the magnificent Dolomite Mountains (*bottom picture*). A UNESCO World Heritage Site, it encompasses 18 peaks, offering some of the most beautiful mountain landscapes: vertical walls, sheer cliffs, narrow deep valleys, and charming villages. We will enjoy a panoramic scenic drive with photo stops alongside spectacular alpine meadows, pristine valleys, and sparkling-clear lakes. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 7 – EAGLE'S NEST~LAKE KONIGSSEE: After breakfast, we cross back over into Germany to Berchtesgaden, an area of spectacular natural beauty and a favorite retreat of Bavarian kings. We will visit Hitler's mountain retreat, Eagle's Nest, a mountain-top lodge built by the Nazis, and a major drawing card for the region. Afterwards, we'll enjoy a relaxing boat cruise on Konigsee, the deepest and cleanest lake in Germany, surrounded by steep mountains reaching 8900 feet. We'll have lunch at St. Bartholomä (*on our own*), with its famous pilgrimage church. This quaint town is located on a peninsula half-way down the lake's western shore. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 8 – SALZBURG: After breakfast, we drive to Salzburg, home of both Mozart and "The Sound of Music." Our Tour Escort will take us on a tour where we will discover the history behind this beautiful city. Another UNESCO World Heritage Site and surrounded by scenic Alpine mountains, Salzburg has some renowned baroque architecture and one of the best-preserved city centers. We will return to Innsbruck in the late afternoon for a special farewell dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 9 – MUNICH~INTERMEDIATE CITY~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to Munich Airport for our flight to Boston (*via intermediate city*), with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight. (B)

OUR ALPINE ADVENTURE TOUR INCLUDES:

- ◆ Round-trip motorcoach transportation to and from Boston's Logan Airport. FREE with a minimum of 35 paying passengers. Additional charge with fewer than 35.
- ◆ Round-trip regularly scheduled transatlantic flights Boston-to-Munich (*via intermediate city*) and return with complimentary meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight.
- ◆ Special meet-and-greet service and assistance at Logan Airport by a Durgan Travel Service Representative.

- ◆ All room and meal tax (for included meals)
