OUR 9-DAY/7-NIGHT STAY PUT SCOTLAND ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~GLASGOW OR EDINBURGH: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport for our evening departure for Scotland (via intermediate city) with full meal and beverage service available while in flight.

DAY 2 – GLASGOW OR EDINBURGH~DRYMEN: Upon arrival in Scotland, we will meet our Tour Escort, who will help us transfer to the Winnock Hotel (or similar) in Drymen, near Loch Lomond, where we will spend the next seven nights. Dinner will be served at the hotel this evening. (D)

DAY 3 – EDINBURGH: After breakfast, today we'll enjoy a full-day visit to Edinburgh. We will take a guided panoramic tour to view the historic Edinburgh Castle, the Royal Mile, Holyroodhouse Palace, the famous Princes Street, and many of the lovely Georgian terraces of the "New Town." Lunch is at leisure in one of the bustling pubs. After lunch, we will have time for shopping and individual sightseeing. Depart from Edinburgh late afternoon and arrive back in Drymen in time to relax before dinner. (B, D)

DAY 4 – EDINBURGH & LEITH: This morning, after breakfast, depart for Leith to visit the former Royal Yacht Britannia. This magnificent ship has played host to some of the most famous people in the world. But, above all, she was home to Her Majesty The Queen and the Royal Family. Now in Edinburgh, you are welcome onboard to discover the heart and soul of this most special of royal residences. Enjoy free time in Edinburgh city before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight (B, D)

DAY 5– GLASGOW: After breakfast, we will drive to Glasgow, to enjoy a panoramic tour of the city, followed by a visit to the Cathedral of St. Mungo, the oldest building in Glasgow. We will also visit the Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum, one of Glasgow's great landmarks. With an ever-changing array of exhibits, one of its most famous treasures is Salvador Dali's iconic "Christ of St. John on the Cross." Free time in Glasgow before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 6 – LOCH LOMOND & INVERARAY CASTLE: After breakfast, we'll enjoy a cruise on Loch Lomond, the largest surface area of fresh water in the UK. The area is known for its beauty and tranquility and offers picture postcard views around every corner. We'll also visit remarkable Inverary Castle before returning to Drymen for dinner and overnight. (B, D)



DAY 7 – STERLING & FALKIRK: After breakfast, today we'll enjoy a great day of sightseeing. visit Stirling to visit to the famous castle, a medieval old town, and the William Wallace ("*Braveheart*") Monument. Then it's on to Falkirk to visit the Falkirk Wheel, a rotating boat lift connecting canals throughout Scotland. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 8 – AYRSHIRE: After breakfast, we will drive to visit the famous Burrell Collection. We'll stop in Ayrshire and Robert Burns country for a visit to the Burns Birthplace Museum and Robert Burns Cottage before continuing on down the lovely Ayrshire Coast to Culzean Castle, with its strong links with the Kennedy family. We return to Drymen to enjoy a "Farewell Dinner" at a local restaurant in Drymen this evening. (B, D)

DAY 9 – DRYMEN~GLASGOW OR EDINBURGH~BOSTON: After a last hearty Scottish breakfast, we depart for Glasgow/Edinburgh Airport for our flight to Boston (*via intermediate city*) with meal and beverage service while in flight. (B)
