DAY 1 BOSTON-LONDON. Depart Boston's Logan International Airport on an overnight flight to London, with dinner and complimentary beverage service included aboard.

DAY 2 ARRIVAL IN LONDON, ENGLAND. Upon arrival, we will be met by our tour host, who will assist us with boarding our motorcoach to our first-class hotel in London. Dinner and overnight at the hotel. (D)

DAY 3 LONDON. Morning sightseeing with a professional London guide includes all the famous landmarks: Royal Albert Hall, Kensington Palace and the area's splendid museums, Knightsbridge with Harrods, the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben beside the River Thames, and Westminster Abbey. Highlights are a visit to St. Paul's Cathedral and the Changing of the Guard at Buckingham Palace (if held). Free time in the afternoon for shopping, relaxing, or individual sightseeing. Dinner is included this evening. (B,D)

DAY 4 LONDON-HAMPTON COURT-STONEHENGE-BATH. After breakfast and hotel check-out, we depart for a memorable day of sightseeing. First, a special visit to admire the breathtaking ornamental gardens of Henry VIII's Hampton Court Palace. Your Tour Director will take you on a walk to see the Great Vine, Pond Garden, Privy Garden, and the flower borders of the Great Fountain Garden. Then, westward to the intriguing prehistoric monument of Stonehenge. Explore the stunning new visitor center with its imaginative exhibitions, then take the shuttle to the stone circle and admire the magnificence of the monument up close. Across Salisbury Plain, head for the elegant Georgian city of Bath, where you see the amazing excavations of the Roman Baths. Tonight, enjoy a welcome dinner with wine at your hotel. (B,D)

DAY 5 BATH-STOW-STRATFORD-LLANGOLLEN, WALES-CHESTER. Savor vistas of the Cotswolds on your way via the medieval market town of Stow-on-the-Wold to Stratford-upon-Avon. Time here to see SHAKESPEARE'S BIRTHPLACE and for pictures of Anne Hathaway's Cottage. The afternoon is dedicated to North Wales. Enjoy yourself in picturesque Llangollen, home of an annual international contest for poets and minstrels. Then it's on to Chester for hotel check-in, dinner, and overnight. (B,D)

DAY 6 CHESTER-GRASMERE-GRETNA GREEN, SCOTLAND-EDINBURGH. This morning's walking tour includes the Roman remains, black and white half-timbered buildings, the cathedral, and the two-tiered shopping arcades called the "Rows." Focus now on the tranquil Lake District, considered to be the finest of England's national parks. Take a break in Wordsworth's beloved Grasmere, and try original Grasmere Gingerbread. Then, head north for the Scottish border. On the way through the history-steeped Lowland Hills, stop at Gretna Green, where the blacksmith used to wed runaway couples. After arrival in the Scottish capital, we will have a Scottish evening with Highland dancers, bagpipers, and the Ceremony of the Haggis (B,D)

DAY 7 EDINBURGH. A full day to enjoy this "Prince of Cities." Morning sightseeing with a local expert starts with an orientation drive along Princes Street and the Royal Mile, and tales of some truly intriguing characters: the Bodysnatchers, Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde, and Greyfriars Bobby. History comes alive as you tour mighty EDINBURGH CASTLE and the Queen's HOLYROOD PALACE. Afternoon and evening at leisure. (B)

DAY 8 EDINBURGH-ABBOTSFORD-JEDBURGH-YORK, ENGLAND. First on today's agenda is Sir Walter Scott's ABBOTSFORD HOUSE, where Dame Jean Maxwell-Scott often guides our tours herself. Melrose Abbey and the ruins at Jedburgh are pointed out on the way to the English border and Northumberland National Park. South now to York, England's most complete medieval city. Stand in awe in front of the great structure of York Minster, then follow your tour director through a maze of quaint streets including the narrow Shambles. Spend the night in the flower-festooned garden spa of Harrogate. (B,D)

DAY 9 STAMFORD-CAMBRIDGE-LONDON. Leave Yorkshire and its associations with James Herriot, and drive through the richest farmland in Britain for a highlight visit to BELVOIR CASTLE. The stately home of the Duke and Duchess of Rutland houses one of England's finest private art collections. Finally visit the beautiful university city of Cambridge, one of the country's oldest seats of learning. Return to London around 4 p.m. How about taking in one of the great West End shows tonight? (FB)

DAY 10 LONDON-BOSTON. After breakfast and checkout at your hotel, we will return to the airport for our return flight to Boston's Logan International Airport. (CB)
