OUR COASTAL TOUR OF SPAIN ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~ ZURICH ~MALAGA: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our transatlantic flight (*expected to be on Swiss Air via Zurich*) to Malaga, Spain with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in flight.

DAY 2 – COSTA DEL SOL: "*Bienvenida a España!*" Upon arrival in Malaga, Spain, we will meet tour escort, who will help us transfer to our hotel, the Tryp Malaga Alameda (or similar). Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (D)

DAY 3 – MALAGA-TORREMOLINOS: After breakfast at our hotel, we will enjoy a guided morning tour of Malaga. During our tour, we will visit Alcazaba, the city's most distinctive building, a military fortress built by the Moors, which sits on the hillside overlooking the coast. After lunch (*on our own*), we are off to Torremolinos, where we will enjoy a panoramic city tour, as well as some time at leisure. Later, we will return to Malaga for dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – RONDA: After breakfast, we are off on a full-day excursion to Ronda, which is situated on a rocky precipice in the Serrania de Ronda Mountains. Here, kings and nobles sought out the peacefulness of the mountains and the incredible views of the river from the heights of the walkways. We will visit the Church of St. Maria la Mayor, the Ronda Bullring, the oldest in Spain and the home of modern bullfighting, and the Don Bosco House. We will have lunch in Ronda at the *Restaurant Escudero*. Return to Torremolinos for some leisure time prior to dinner this evening. Overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 5 – MALAGA~CARTAGENA~VALENCIA: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will depart for Valencia. En route, we will stop in Cartagena and enjoy lunch. Upon arrival in Valencia, we will check into our first-class hotel, the Hotel Abba Acteon (or similar) for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 – VALENCIA: After breakfast, we are off on a guided morning tour of Valencia. The third largest city in Spain, Valencia is full of traditions and festivities. The city has a very rich history, which shows in its historical and monumental heritage, as well as the diverse scenic and cultural sites. After our tour, we will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, followed by an afternoon at leisure to explore this city, also known as "the city of flowers," due to its many beautiful gardens. This evening, we will enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 7 –VALENCIA~BARCELONA: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will depart for Barcelona. Upon arrival, we will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant and check in to our first-class hotel, the Hotel Husa Avenida Palace (or similar). The remainder of our afternoon will be at leisure to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 8 – BARCELONA: After breakfast, we are off on a full-day city tour of Barcelona, during which we will see many of the city's most historic and famous landmarks. Our tour will also include an inside view of Barcelona's most iconic and controversial structure – *the Templo Expiatorio de la Sagrada Familia* – the unfinished monumental church designed by Antoni Gaudi. Then we will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. Next we will visit Guell Park, adorned with more of Gaudi's works, including the entrance to the park, the Gaudi dragon fountain. We will enjoy dinner at *Marina Monchos* (or similar). Overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 9 – SANT SADURNI d'ANOIA: After breakfast, we will continue to see the sights of Barcelona during an escorted morning city tour. After lunch, we will venture out to St. Sadurni d'Anoia, a land of vineyards known as the Cava Capital. We will visit a cava cellar and sample this "Spanish champagne." Return to our hotel in Barcelona for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 10 – BARCELONA~ZURICH ~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the airport to board our return flight to Boston (*via Zurich*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in flight. (B)
