## OUR 8-DAY/6-NIGHT DUBLIN CITY STAY ITINERARY:

**DAY 1 – BOSTON~DUBLIN:** Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our non-stop overnight flight to Dublin with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight.

**DAY 2 – DUBLIN:** Welcome to Ireland! Upon arrival at Dublin airport, we will meet our Tour Escort who will help us transfer. A panoramic tour is the ideal introduction to "Dublin's Fair City." The tour will introduce us to the principal sites, which we can then revisit at our leisure. We will visit the elegant Georgian squares, famous for their architecture, especially their doors. We continue to St Patrick's Cathedral. Built in 1192, it is one of Ireland's largest cathedrals, made famous by its former Dean Jonathan Swift, author of "Gulliver's Travels." We will also see Christchurch, built by the Anglo-Normans in 1172 to replace an earlier Church built by the Vikings in 1038, on our way to Phoenix Park with its many monuments, including the Papal Cross. We'll return to the city center via the Quays, passing by the Guinness brewery and Collins Barrack, before arriving back at O'Connell Street and the city center. We then visit Trinity College with the 9<sup>th</sup> century Book of Kells, one of Ireland's most illustrious books. Before viewing the famous book, we will pass through an exhibition, based on the book of Kells and other important books written in monasteries around Ireland from the 9<sup>th</sup> century. After viewing the Book of Kells, we will visit the long room, built in 1745. Once the principal library of the University, it now contains over 200,000 books and manuscripts of Trinity's oldest volumes. Brian Boru's harp, said to be the "oldest harp in Ireland," and a copy of the 1916 Proclamation, one of the most important documents relating to Irish history, are also on display in the Long Room. We'll enjoy lunch at a local bar/restaurant. Check into our hotel for overnight. (L)

**DAY 3 – DUBLIN:** After breakfast at our hotel, the day is at leisure to explore Dublin on our own and enjoy some independent sightseeing, shopping, and browsing. Overnight. (B)

**DAY 4 – DUBLIN:** After breakfast, this is another day at leisure to explore Dublin on our own. Overnight. (B)

**DAY 5 – DUBLIN:** After breakfast, this is another day at leisure to explore Dublin on our own and enjoy some independent sightseeing, shopping, and browsing. Overnight. (B)

**DAY 6 – DUBLIN:** After breakfast, this is our final day at leisure to explore Dublin. Optional tours are available (*at additional expense*). Overnight. (B)

**DAY 7 – DUBLIN:** After breakfast, we will visit The Temple Bar, an area on the south bank of the River Liffey in central Dublin. Unlike the areas surrounding it, Temple Bar has preserved its medieval street pattern, with many narrow cobbled streets. It is promoted as "Dublin's cultural quarter" and has a lively nightlife. Our farewell dinner and entertainment this evening is at the Arlington Hotel Temple Bar. (B, D)

**DAY 8 – DUBLIN~ BOSTON:** After our final breakfast in Ireland, we will transfer to Dublin Airport for our nonstop return flight, with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. (B)
