OUR 10-DAY/8-NIGHT EASTERN EUROPE INTINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE STOP~WARSAW: Depart Boston aboard our transatlantic flight to Warsaw (*via intermediate stop*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight.

DAY 2 – WARSAW: Upon arrival in Warsaw, we'll meet our Tour Escort and transfer to our hotel. Warsaw is an extraordinary city in which historic buildings, palaces, churches, and architectural complexes destroyed during WWII have been reconstructed with great care. We'll check into the *Westin Warsaw* (or similar) Tonight we'll enjoy a special welcome dinner. Overnight. (D)

DAY 3 – WARSAW~KRAKOW: After breakfast and hotel check-out, today we'll enjoy a half-day guided tour of Warsaw, including the attractive Old Town, the Monument of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising, and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Then we'll head to history-rich Krakow, the city that represents all things Polish, connecting tradition with modernity. En route, we'll stop in Czestochowa to visit the 14th century Jasna Gora Monastery to see the most important icon of Mary in this part of Europe, The Black Madonna of Czestochowa. Upon arrival in Krakow, we'll check into the *Holiday Inn City Center* (or similar) for a two-night stay. Enjoy the evening at leisure. Overnight. (B)

DAY 4 – KRAKOW~AUSCHWITZ: After breakfast, we'll take a half-day tour of Krakow, where we'll see Market Square, the University and Wawel Castle (top photo), once the residence of Polish kings. Later, we'll visit St. Mary's Church, built in the 14th century to see its famed wooden altarpiece. Next, we'll travel to Auschwitz for a somber but important visit. A local expert will guide us through this former concentration camp and museum. Tonight, we'll enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight. (B, D)

DAY 5 – KRAKOW~BUDAPEST: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll depart for Budapest. With its complex and often embittered history, incredible architecture, and rich cultural heritage, Hungary's capital deserves its reputation as the "Paris of Central Europe." We'll check into the *Hotel Mercure Korona* (or similar) for a two-night stay, and then enjoy dinner. Overnight. (B, D)

DAY 6 – BUDAPEST: After breakfast, we'll take a half-day guided tour of Budapest, where we'll visit the Fisherman's Bastion and see the Mathias Church, the New Parliament, Gellert Hill, and the Citadel. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore this amazing city on our own. Overnight. (B)

DAY 7 – BUAPEST~VIENNA: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll depart for Vienna. En route, we'll stop in Esztergom, which was the capital of Hungary from the 10th until the mid-13th century. Continue to Vienna, described as Europe's cultural capital – a metropolis with unique charm, vibrancy, and flair. Upon arrival, we'll enjoy a Vienna city tour to see the state Opera House and St. Stephan's Cathedral. We'll also visit and tour the Schoenbrunn Palace. Then we'll check into the *Renaissance* (or similar) for overnight. (B)

DAY 8 – VIENNA~PRAGUE: After breakfast and hotel check-out, sit back and enjoy the scenery today as we travel to Prague, Czech Republic. Our first stop is in Telc; the entire town has been designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We'll enjoy some leisure time here. Later, we'll arrive in Prague and check into *Courtyard Flora* (or similar). Largely undamaged by WWII, the cityscape is stunning. Its compact medieval center remains an evocative maze of cobbled lanes, ancient courtyards, dark passages, and churches beyond number – all watched over by an 1100-year-old castle. The evening is at leisure to explore Prague. Overnight. (B)

DAY 9 – PRAGUE: After breakfast, this morning we'll enjoy a guided tour of Prague, featuring a visit to the historic Hradcany Castle. We'll see the famed Golden Lane. Later, we'll enjoy a leisurely walk in the Old Jewish Quarter and a visit to St. Vitus Cathedral. This cathedral, an excellent example of Gothic architecture, is the biggest and most important church in the country. This evening we'll enjoy a special farewell dinner at a popular local restaurant. Overnight. (B, D)

DAY 10 – PRAGUE ~INTERMEDIATE CITY~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the airport, where we will board our return flight to Boston (*via intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight. (B)
