OUR WONDERS OF EGYPT TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE CITY~CAIRO: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our transatlantic flight to Cairo, Egypt (*via Intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight.

DAY 2 – CAIRO, EGYPT: Arrival at the airport in Cairo where we will be met by our Tour Escort who will assist with our transfer. Board our private motorcoach for the drive to the superior first-class *Barcelo Hotel* (or similar) for check-in. The remainder of the day is at leisure to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings. Dinner at our hotel this evening. Overnight. (D)

DAY 3 – PYRAMIDS OF GIZA: After breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for the Pyramids of Giza. Cheops' pyramid is the largest ever built, nearby stands the Pyramid of Chephren virtually as large, and somewhat to the west, lays the smallest pyramid of Mykerinos. To complete this wonderful archeological site, we shall view the enigmatic figure of the Sphinx their Guardian. Continue tour to Sakkara, beginning at Memphis, the first capital of Ancient Egypt. We will view a colossal statue of King Ramses II as well as the famous alabaster Sphinx. From Memphis, we make a short drive to the Necropolis at Saqqara and see the Step Pyramids of King Djoser. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – CAIRO: Breakfast at our hotel. Our guided sightseeing begins with a visit to the fabulous Egyptian Museum of Antiquities which houses over 120,000 priceless Egyptian artifacts, and is world-famous as the repository of the wonders of the Tomb of King Tutankhamun. Following our tour, we will enjoy an afternoon of leisure for lunch and to explore Cairo on our own. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 5 – CAIRO~LUXOR~NILE CRUISING: After breakfast and hotel check out, transfer to the airport for the short flight to Luxor where we will board our cruise vessel and begin our Nile cruise. Lunch aboard. In the afternoon, we will visit two outstanding examples of ancient Egyptian architecture – the Temple of Karnak and the Temple of Luxor. Dinner and overnight aboard. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 – NILE CRUISING: Breakfast and lunch aboard our cruise vessel. Today's itinerary includes visits to the vast burial city on the Nile's West Bank, the Colossi of Memnon (*two massive stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III*), the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut (*one of the few female pharaohs*), and the Valley of the Kings (*where from the 16th to 11th century BC the rulers and nobles of Egypt were buried*). Enjoy dinner and overnight on board. (B, L, D)

DAY 7 – NILE CRUISING: Breakfast and lunch aboard our cruise vessel. Our cruise continues meandering along the Nile to Edfu to visit the Temple of Horus (*the falcon-headed god closely associated with the pharaoh*). Next stop on our cruise is at Kom Ombo to visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, an unusual double temple built during the Ptolemaic dynasty. Dinner and overnight on board. (B, L, D)

DAY 8 – NILE CRUISING: Breakfast and lunch aboard our cruise vessel. This morning, we will visit the Temple dedicated for Isis on Philae Island and the unfinished Obelisk. We also visit the High Dam passing by the Old Dam of Aswan. This afternoon, we will view the elephantine Island, the Botanical Gardens, and the Agha Khan Mausoleum by Felucca. Dinner and overnight aboard our cruise vessel. (B, L, D)

DAY 9 – NILE CRUISING~ASWAN~CAIRO: Breakfast aboard our cruise vessel. Arriving in Aswan, we will disembark and transfer to the airport for our flight to Cairo, where we will check in at the first-class *Barcelo Hotel* (or similar). The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore on our own or shop for that last-minute, special gift. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 10 – CAIRO~INTERMEDIATE CITY~BOSTON: Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the airport in Cairo to board our return flight to Boston (*via Intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight. (B)
