OUR EMILIA ROMAGNA TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~ROME~BOLOGNA: Depart Boston’s Logan International Airport aboard our transatlantic flight to Bologna (*via intermediate city*) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight.

DAY 2 – BOLOGNA~RIMINI: “*Benvenuti in Italia!*” Upon arrival at Guglielmo Marconi Airport in Bologna, we will meet our Tour Escort who will help us transfer. From here, we will board our private motorcoach for the drive to the beach resort of Rimini on the beautiful Adriatic Coast. Upon arrival, we will check into a four-star hotel located on the beach in Rimini. The remainder of the day is at leisure to familiarize ourselves with our surroundings. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (D)

DAY 3 – REPUBLIC OF SAN MARINO: After breakfast at our hotel, we’ll board our motorcoach for a morning drive to the third-smallest country in Europe, officially known as “The Most Serene Republic of San Marino.” On our guided tour, we will see the Gothic Palazzo Pubblico, the colorful Fortress Guards at the Piazza della Libertà, the 14th century Church of San Francesco, the Palazzo dei Valloni, the Neo-Classical Basilica of San Marino, and many other historic sites. Our tour ends at the Fortress of Mount Titano, which offers tremendous panoramic views of the surrounding countryside and the Adriatic Sea. Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – BOLOGNA: After breakfast, today’s excursion takes us to one of Italy’s most historic, yet modern centers – Bologna! Bologna, one of the oldest cities in Italy, lies at the foot of the Apennine Mountains and has long been known for its graceful architecture, outstanding universities, and mouth-watering cuisine. Our local guide will acquaint us with the area around the Main Square, including the Church of San Petronio (*with its unfinished façade*), the fantastic Statue of Neptune of Giambolognas, the famous Middle Age towers – Torre Garisenda and Torre Asinelli – and many other important landmarks. Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 5 – PARMA: After breakfast, we head out to Parma. Upon arrival, we’ll enjoy a guided tour of the historic center. Our tour will include Palazzo Ducale, the Baptistery, Strada and Piazza Garibaldi, the St. Giovanni Evangelista Church, the Duomo, and the University (*in a 16th century building*). We will then travel to Busseto, birthplace of the famous composer, Giuseppe Verdi. Later we continue to Langhirano for a visit to a ham factory. Here, we will enjoy a light lunch with ham and local products. Afterwards, we will return to the hotel, with time to relax and freshen up prior to dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 – MODENA: Breakfast at our hotel. Today, we will visit the idyllic town of Modena which is probably most famous as “the home of Ferrari motorcars”, but in truth is an historic center which reflects the culture and life of the surrounding area. Our local guide will take us on an informative walking tour of many of Modena’s most historic venues, including the 12th century Romanesque Cathedral (declared by UNESCO to be among 500 masterpieces worldwide), the impressive Municipal Palace, the imposing Palazzo Ducale. Early afternoon we will continue to the countryside of Modena for visiting the “Aceitaia di Giorgio <http://www.acetaiadigiorgio.it/> for enjoying a balsamic vinegar tasting! Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 7 – FERRARI MOTORCARS~FERRARA: Breakfast at our hotel. Today we will visit FERRARI MOTORCARS. We drive to Maranello for an exclusive panoramic tour of the Fiorano Track and Enzo Ferrari into the Factory. The guide will illustrate the characteristics and contents of the circuit of the Ferrari, where tests of race cars and roads have been carried out since 1972, and Citadel Ferrari, the heart of the plants where all the cars of Cavallino are produced. Of particular interest are the architectural structures of renowned architects such as Renzo Piano, Massimiliano Fuksas, Jean Nouvelle, Marco Visconti and Luigi Sturchio. At the end of the tour, the guide will lead us to the Ferrari museum visit to show us the red carriages! Free time for a light lunch at the Ferrari store. In the afternoon, we will continue to Ferrara, which still preserves its Renaissance-era atmosphere when it was the seat of the court of the powerful Este family. With our local guide, we will explore Ferrara’s twisting, medieval cobblestone streets, visit the magnificent Cathedral with its towering Gothic façade, and – best of all – the Castello Estense, a castle straight out of the storybooks with a moat, drawbridges and towers! Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (B, D)



DAY 8 – FICO EATALY: Following breakfast at our hotel, we are off for a full-day excursion to the brand-new FICO Eataly food theme park in Bologna. Laid out over 100,000 square meters and featuring 40 restaurants and refreshment stations, six educational rides, shopping, demonstrations, and more, this new attraction is the largest “Agri-Theme Park” in all of Europe! Lunch, with its myriad options here, is on your own. Return to our hotel in Rimini for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 9 – BOLOGNA~ROME~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to Guglielmo Marconi Airport in Bologna to board our return flight to Boston (*via Rome*) with meal and beverage service, available while in flight. (B)
