## OUR CHRISTMAS MARKETS OF EUROPE TOUR ITINERARY:

**DAY 1 – BOSTON-INTERMEDIATE CITY~FRANKFURT:** Departure from Boston's Logan International Airport on our transatlantic flight to Frankfurt, Germany (*via possible intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight.

**DAY 2 – FRANKFURT~ROTHENBURG:** Upon our arrival in Frankfurt, we meet our Tour Escort and driver. We'll then experience our first – of many! – Christmas Markets in Rothenburg. People meet in the markets to shop and visit with friends over a cup of Christmas cheer. Our accommodations for the next three nights are in Rothenburg, a well-preserved medieval town. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (D)

**DAY 3 – ROTHENBURG:** After breakfast at our hotel, we'll take a short walking tour of Rothenburg. This market, dating back to the 15<sup>th</sup> century, is one of the oldest in Germany. Each day there are several cultural events, ranging from organ concerts to a puppet theatre. Experience this fairytale-like atmosphere with winding passageways, torch-lit walks, and the scent of "glühwein" (*hot spiced wine*), at the Christmas Market. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure to take in the intriguing sights and sounds. (B)

**DAY 4 – NUREMBERG:** After breakfast, we depart for Nuremberg, where a local guide joins us for a tour of the city. As we stroll through the streets, we are greeted by the sweet scents of the gingerbread for which Nuremberg is famous, along with bratwurst, roasted almonds, and "glühwein." The sight of endless Christmas decorations around the city will be sure to put a sparkle in our eyes. The Christmas Market here is one of the largest and most well-known in the world, and we'll have the opportunity to browse its colorful, festive stalls. Return to Rothenburg for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

**Day 5 – REGENSBURG~PRAGUE:** After breakfast and hotel check-out, today's journey takes us through the winter wonderland of Bavaria to Regensburg. This unique town has an abundance of history, making it a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We have time for lunch and then to pay a visit to the many craft stalls, including the traditional Christkindlmarket and the romantic Christmas Market. Later we arrive in Prague, considered one of the most beautiful cities in the world, where we'll check into our hotel for the next three nights. Dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**DAY 6 – PRAGUE:** After breakfast, we will take a guided city tour of Prague. We'll explore the Prague Castle complex and see courtyards, St. Vitus Cathedral, and the Royal Palace. We'll also discover Prague's Old Town, and Josefov, Prague's Jewish community. There are opportunities to shop for Bohemian crystal, considered the best in the world, and pottery. Discover the uniqueness and beauty of Prague at your leisure this evening. (B)

**DAY 7 – PRAGUE AT LEISURE:** After breakfast, we'll continue our discovery of the city of Prague. Built on seven hills along the Vltava River, this extraordinary city is known for its incomparable architecture. Over its 900-year history, Prague has combined the best of Romanesque, Gothic, Renaissance, Baroque, and Art Nouveau styles to create an architectural collage of enormous beauty. We'll have time to shop at Prague's Christmas Market before our farewell dinner. Then we are off to a concert in one of Prague's concert halls. (B, D)

**DAY 8 – PRAGUE~INTERMEDIATE CITY~BOSTON:** After breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll transfer to the airport in Prague to board our return flight to Boston (*via intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. (B).
