OUR 8-DAY/6-NIGHT BEER LOVERS' OKTOBERFEST TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE CITY~MUNICH: Board our overnight transatlantic flight to Munich, Germany (*via possible intermediate city*) with complimentary meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight.

DAY 2 – MUNICH~SALZBURG: Upon arrival, we will meet our Tour Escort and transfer to Salzburg. Upon our arrival in Salzburg, a local guide will take us on an exciting city tour of Salzburg, showing us the highlights of this unique city! After, we will check into the 4-star hotel *Amedia* (or similar) in Salzburg. Then, we will visit Austria's largest private brewery, "Stiegl Brauwelt," followed by a tasting of different Stiegl specialty beers. We will also have the chance to show our talent by tapping a beer barrel! Finally we'll enjoy a welcome dinner at Stiegl's Brauwelt Restaurant. Overnight at our hotel. (BT, D)

DAY 3 – EAGLE'S NEST~KONIGSEE: After breakfast, we'll cross over into Germany for a visit to Obersalzberg, location of Eagle's Nest, Hitler's summer home perched high in the Bavarian Alps, with beautiful views of both Germany and Austria. Afterwards, we will have lunch at Konigsee (*King's Lake*), the deepest and cleanest lake in Germany, and then enjoy a cruise on Konigsee. Dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 4 – MUNICH OKTOBERFEST: After breakfast, we will depart for Munich. Upon arrival, we start with a guided city tour of the fun-filled Bavarian capital. The tour passes the Olympic Stadium with its amazing "hanging roof" and continues along the imposing Ludwigstrasse, past the university and Victory Arch into the heart of the city. At the Marienplatz, crowds gather outside the soaring neo-gothic Town Hall to watch the colorful Glockenspiel. In the afternoon, we have reserved tables at one of the famous giant beer tents at the Oktoberfest "Wies'n." Our luncheon reservation includes a voucher for half a chicken and two tankards of beer. Return to Salzburg for overnight. (B, L)

DAY 5 – SALZBURG: After breakfast, we'll enjoy a day at leisure, for individual sightseeing. The possibilities are endless: There's the Cathedral, Mozart's house, the Abbey, Hohensalzburg Castle, the oldest café (dating back to the 8th century!), St. Peter's, or Mirabell Gardens, from "The Sound of Music." There are also numerous cafes in which to relax. Lunch and dinner are on our own. Overnight. (B)

DAY 6 – CESKY KRUMLOV~CESKY BUDJEVICE~PRAGUE: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we depart Salzburg for the trip north to Prague. En route we will stop to visit the UNESCO World Heritage town of Cesky Krumlov and take a tour of the old town. We'll enjoy lunch at the brewery/restaurant Eggenberg, including two beers! After, we'll continue on to Ceske Budejovice, the Czech Republic's most famous brewing town after Pilsen. The old German name for Budejovice is "Budweis," and beer known as Budweiser is served around the world. We'll visit the Budweiser Budvar Visitor Centre and then enjoy a guided brewery tour, where we will see how the world-famous Budweiser Budvar lager is made, and enjoy a sample. Then we'll continue on to Prague and check into the *Hotel Christie* (or similar). Tonight we'll enjoy dinner at brewery/restaurant Neustädter (Novomestsky Privovar), including two beers! Overnight. (B, L, BT, D)

DAY 7 – PRAGUE: After breakfast, we start our full-day city tour of the highlights of Prague, including visits to the main sights: Charles Bridge, National Theatre, the lesser town (*Mala Strana*), Church of Our Lady Victorious with its famous Prague Infant Jesus, and the Jewish Quarter. After lunch (*on our own*), we'll continue our city tour with the Old Town Square, the Pudergatter, the Town Hall, and Wenceslas Square. We'll enjoy dinner at the famous U Fleku brewery/restaurant, including two beers! Overnight. (B, D)

DAY 8 – PRAGUE~PILSEN~PRAGUE: After breakfast, we'll conclude our sightseeing with a half-day tour of Prague. We start at Prague's Loreto, known as the Loreta in Czech, which is a sanctuary or palace. Afterwards we will tour the famous Prague Castle with the Saint Vitus Cathedral, the Royal Palace, and the famous Golden Lane. Mid-morning, we'll drive to Pilsen, where we'll enjoy lunch, including two beers, at the brewery/restaurant Na Splice, followed by a guided tour through the famous Pilsner Urquell brewery. During our tour, we will see the brewing house, the historical cellars, and the cylindroconic tanks. Return to Prague in the afternoon. Tonight's special farewell dinner is at the Strahov Monastic Brewery (*Klasterni Pivovar*) with tasty food, cold beer, and music! Overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 9 – PRAGUE~INTERMEDIATE CITY~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the airport, where we will board our return flight to Boston (*via possible intermediate city*), with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. (B)
