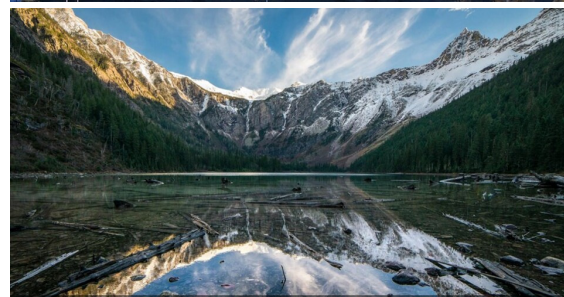
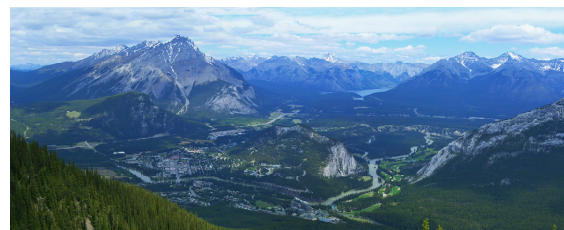

OUR CANADIAN ROCKIES & GLACIER NATIONAL PARK TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON TO EDMONTON: Fly from Boston to Edmonton (possible intermediate stop). Welcome to Canada and the beautiful province of Alberta. Once you have cleared Canadian Customs and Immigration, meet your Tour Manager and board your deluxe private motorcoach and begin your Canadian Rockies adventure. If time permits, enjoy a brief city tour of Alberta's Capital City. This is Canada's largest "Northern" city, and has a great place in Canadian history. Tonight enjoy a welcome dinner and get prepared for an early departure for Jasper National Park. *Overnight Edmonton – Sutton Place Hotel or similar (D)*

DAY 2 – JASPER: Depart Edmonton this morning and follow the mighty Athabasca River towards the Canadian Rockies. Soon the rugged peaks of the Rocky Mountains come into view and herald your arrival in the beautiful resort community of Jasper. In the early afternoon enjoy a scenic driver to enchanting Maligne Lake for a spectacular 90-minute cruise on the lake including a stop at mystical Spirit Island. Tonight, breathe in the clear mountain air and enjoy a special Bar-B-Q dinner and nature presentation by a Park Naturalist. *Overnight Jasper – Chateau Jasper or Similar (B, D)*

DAY 3 – JASPER-COLUMBIA ICEFIELDS-BANFF: Another spectacular day lies ahead as you south along the world famous Icefield Highway stopping first at the thundering Athabasca Falls. Today's journey will traverse two 6,000 ft mountain passes, five separate river systems, dozens of mountain streams and lakes and the largest Glacial mass south of the Arctic Circle. At the top of the Sunwapta Pass you'll enter Jasper National Park and catch your first glimpse of the massive Columbia Icefields. Board a specially designed Ice Explorer vehicle and trundle out on the 1,000 foot thick Athabasca Glacier. Your journey continues south driving alongside glacial rivers and past the azure blue waters of Bow and Peyto Lakes. Soon the Icefield Highway joins the Trans Canada highway and the coach heads east following the Bow River to the famed Alpine Resort of Banff. *Overnight Banff – Banff Caribou Lodge or similar (B, D)*

DAY 4 – BANFF & LAKE LOUISE: It's time to explore this beautiful Alpine Resort. This morning, enjoy a tour of the Banff area starting with an exciting gondola ride to the top of 7500 ft Sulphur Mountain. The view from the top is spectacular and stretches for miles in every direction. Your tour continues with visits to Bow Falls, the mysterious Hoodoos, and the Cave and Basin UNESCO Heritage site and the iconic Banff Springs Hotel. Later in the morning retrace your route along the Bow River to the Village or Lake Louise. After lunch (on your own) enjoy the scenic switchback road that takes you to the "Jewel of the Rockies" – Lake Louise. Spend the afternoon viewing the lake and spectacular

Victoria Glacier and exploring the shops and galleries of the iconic Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise. Return to Banff in the late afternoon and take a short stroll to Banff's downtown area to enjoy dinner and some shopping. The stores are usually open until 10pm.

Overnight Banff – Overnight Banff Caribou Lodge or similar (B)

DAY 5 – BANFF-BAR U RANCH-WATERTON LAKES: Today, travel “the road less taken” as you leave Banff National Park and travel south through the spectacular Kananaskis (Grizzly) Trail. This route is truly unique for beauty and the amount of wildlife you will likely see. This is definitely a back roads adventure that you will remember! Stop at the Bar-Ranch for lunch and a tour of this historic area. Once the largest ranch in North America, the Bar-U is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. In the afternoon, the tour continues south along the eastern slope of the Rocky Mountains and through the rolling hills of southern Alberta to the magical mountains and lakes of Waterton National Park. Tonight enjoy a walk along the lake and a short tour to the cascading Cameron Falls. *Overnight Waterton Lakes – Prince of Wales or Bayshore Inn Hotel (B, L, D)*

DAY 6 – MANY GLACIER PARK, MONTANA: Welcome the Many Glacier International Park, one of only 2 International Parks shared by Canada and the United States. Crossing into Montana, enjoy the stories of the great Indian tribes who once dominated this area and its culture. Arriving at Lake McDonald, board one of the bright red “jammers” for an amazing 3-hour tour over the famed Going-To-The-Sun Highway. If the weather is good, the driver will roll back the convertible roof on the 17-seat touring car and your viewing will be nothing short of “Awesome!” At the village of St Mary’s, re-board your deluxe private coach for a leisurely return trip to Waterton. Tonight is a free night for you to enjoy the local shops and cuisine. *Overnight Waterton – Prince of Wales or Bayshore Inn Hotel (B)*

DAY 7 – WATERTON LAKES-CALGARY: Today, travel north through the great ranches and oil fields of Southern Alberta. Along the way visit one of the world’s finest collections of carriages at the Remington Carriage Museum and feel the thunder of the vanished herds of Buffalo at the UNESCO world heritage site “Head Smashed In Buffalo Jump”. A visit to the first home of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police in Fort McLeod will round out your day before arriving in the dynamic city of Calgary for the night. Tonight enjoy a special western-style farewell dinner and re-live the sights, adventures and friendships experiences over the past 11 days in Canada

Overnight Calgary – Delta South Hotel or similar (B, D)

DAY 8 – CALGARY TO BOSTON: Transfer to the airport to board our return flight to Boston (possible intermediate stop). (B)
