While in Greece, we will be staying at first-class hotels. From there, we'll board our ship for a magnificent cruise among the picturesque Greek islands!

OUR GREECE & ISLAND CRUISE TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1: BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE CITY~ATHENS: Depart Boston's Logan Airport on our overnight flight to Athens (*via intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headphones, available while in flight.

DAY 2: ATHENS: We will be transferred from the airport in Athens to the Athenian Callirhoe Hotel (or similar) for check-in. The remainder of the afternoon is at our leisure to freshen up and relax prior to dinner. Overnight. (D)

DAY 3: ATHENS: After breakfast, we will board our motorcoach for a morning tour of Athens. We'll see all the highlights, including Handrina's Arch, the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the Constitutions Square, the Catholic Cathedral, the National Library, the residence of the Prime Minister, the residence of the President of Greece (former Royal Palace), and the Panathinaikon Stadium, where the first Olympic Games took place in 1896. Then we'll visit the Acropolis Museum and Archaeological Site. We'll enjoy lunch in the city's historic center and then take a walking tour of this area. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 4: ATHENS~PELOPONNESE~NAFLION: After breakfast and hotel check-out, our first stop today is an excursion to Peloponnese. We'll visit the Corinth Canal, completed in 1893, making Peloponnese an island. We'll stop on the canal bridge and take pictures of the panoramic views. Then it's on to the Epidaurus archaeological site and theater. In its day, Epidaurus was famous as a health spa. We'll visit the sanctuary of Asclepius, the god of medicine, and a small archaeological museum. Then we'll walk through the impressive ancient Theater of Epidaurus, dating back to the third century BC. The theater, which can seat up to 12,000, is famous for its beautiful location and perfect acoustics. We'll enjoy lunch in Ligourio and then visit the Mycenae archaeological site. The site has been inhabited since Neolithic times, giving its name to a civilization with spread throughout the Greek world. Then we'll check into Amalia Nauplia Hotel (or similar) in Nafplion. After we'll take a walking tour of Nafplion before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 5: NAFPLION~KALAMBAKA: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll head to Delphi and visit the archeological site, which comprises the remains of a sanctuary that was the "navel of the world" and had a huge impact on the ancient world. Delphi reached its height in the fourth century BC, when large numbers of pilgrims came to ask advice of its oracle, an old priestess believed to be Apollo's mouthpiece. We'll enjoy lunch in the area and then visit Osios Loucas, dating back to the Byzantine era. Then we'll check into the Amalia Kalambaka Hotel (or similar) for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 6: KALAMBAKA~METEORA~VERIA: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll visit two monasteries in Meteora, the largest, most important complex of Eastern Orthodox monasteries in Greece. We'll enjoy lunch in Kastraki before traveling to Veria. We'll visit the Tribune of St. Paul, the Byzantine Museum, and take a walking tour before checking into the Aiges Melathron Hotel (or similar) in Veria for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 7: VERIA~THESSALONIKI: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we'll take a morning excursion to Vergina, a small town near Veria that became famous in 1977, when archaeologist Manolis Andronikos unearthed the burial site of the kings of Macedon, including the tomb of Philip II, father of Alexander the Great. We'll spend some time in Thessaloniki for shopping or sightseeing and lunch. We'll check into the City Hotel (or similar) in Thessaloniki and enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 8: THESSALONIKI~ATHENS: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will head back to Athens. We'll stop along the way in Dion to visit its archaeological site. After stopping for lunch, we'll continue to Athens and check into the Athenian Callirhoe Hotel (or similar) for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 9: ATHENS~PIRAEUS~MYKONOS: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to Piraeus where we will board our ship. Depart at 11:00. Arrive in Mykonos, Greece at 6:00 p.m. Depart 11:00 p.m. (B)

DAY 10: KUSADASI (TURKEY)~PATMOS (GREECE): Arrive 7:00 a.m. Depart 1:00 pm. Arrive 4:00 p.m. Depart 9:00 p.m.

DAY 11: RHODES: Arrive 7:00 a.m. Depart 6:00 p.m.

DAY 12: CRETE~SANTORINI: Arrive 7:00 a.m. Depart 11:30 a.m. Arrive 4:30 p.m. Depart 9:00 p.m.

DAY 13: PIRAEUS~ATHENS~INTERMEDIATE CITY~BOSTON: After breakfast, we will arrive in the port of Piraeus and transfer to the airport in Athens, where we will board our return flight to Boston (*via an intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in flight. (B)
