OUR 9-DAY/7-NIGHT LONDON & PARIS TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~LONDON: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport for our regularly-scheduled transatlantic flight to London (*possible intermediate city*), with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight.

DAY 2 – LONDON: Upon arrival at the airport in London, we will be met by our Tour Escort who will assist with our transfer. After boarding our private motorcoach, we will take a guided panoramic city tour to see many of London's most historic and important landmarks. Lunch at a local restaurant. Bank stop to exchange currency. Afternoon check-in at the first-class *Hotel Ibis Earls Court* (or similar) in the West End of London. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (L, D)

DAY 3 – LONDON: After breakfast at our hotel, we will continue our guided sightseeing in London, including interior visits of the Tower of London, Westminster Abbey (*including the Nave and the Royal Chapels*), and the British Museum. We also view Big Ben from the Lambeth Bridge. The afternoon is free for us to explore London on our own. Dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – STRATFORD-UPON-AVON: After breakfast, we will take a full-day excursion to the city of birth of William Shakespeare – Stratford-upon-Avon! Our guided sightseeing of many of Stratford-upon-Avon's most historic sites includes inside visits to Shakespeare's Birthplace (*including the exhibition at the Shakespeare Centre*) and the most photographed farmhouse in England – Anne Hathaway's Cottage! Lunch at a local restaurant in the Stratford-upon-Avon area. In the afternoon, we will visit Holy Trinity Church, the parish church where Shakespeare was baptized and buried. Return to London. Dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 5 – LONDON~PARIS: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to St. Pancras International Station to board the Eurostar high-speed train for Paris via "The Chunnel." (*Please note: Eurostar portorage of luggage is not included in the trip price.*) Arriving in Paris, we will stop for lunch at a local restaurant, followed by a panoramic guided sightseeing tour of the "City of Light," including the Eiffel Tower, the Arc de Triomphe, and a visit to Notre Dame Cathedral, located on Île de la Cité, one of the oldest parts of the city, in the middle of the Seine. We will then check in at the first-class *Hotel All Seasons Bercy* (or similar). Dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 6 – VERSAILLES~PARIS: After a hot breakfast at the hotel, we will head out of Paris for this morning's destination – Versailles. We will tour the opulent and breathtaking Palace of Versailles built in the 17th century by Louis XIV, the "Sun King." It took 50 years to complete. We will have plenty of leisure time in Versailles to wander the magnificent grounds and gardens. Stop for lunch. Afternoon return to Paris to tour the Musée Marmottan, home to the world's largest collection of Monet paintings. Dinner and overnight. (HB, L, D)

DAY 7 – CHARTRES~LOIRE VALLEY: After a hot breakfast at our hotel, we are off for a morning tour of the medieval town of Chartres, including Chartres's most famous structure – *La Cathédrale Notre-Dame de Chartres!* After lunch (*on our own*), we will enjoy a panoramic tour of the Loire Valley, a picturesque landscape of great beauty and legendary culture, containing historic towns and villages, great architectural monuments, numerous châteaux, and many renowned fine wines. Return to Paris for dinner and overnight. (HB, D)

DAY 8 – NORMANDY'S D-DAY BEACHES: After a hot breakfast at our hotel, we will depart for a full-day excursion to the D-Day Beaches in Normandy, first stopping at St. Laurent-sur-Mer to visit the Omaha Museum, which displays arms and equipment used in the assault on Omaha Beach in 1944. Next on our agenda is Pointe du Hoc, the famous cliffs and German strong points which were assaulted by the U. S. Army Ranger Assault Group under the command of Lieutenant Colonel James Earl Rudder. We will stop in Colleville-sur-Mer for lunch (*on our own*). This afternoon, we will visit the hallowed ground of the American U. S. Military Cemetery to honor those who paid the ultimate price to preserve freedom. Last on our agenda today is a stop in Arromanches-les-Bains to visit "SAEM Arromanches 360", which is 360 degree circular theater created to commemorate the Fiftieth Anniversary of the D-Day Landings. Return to our hotel in Paris for dinner and overnight. (HB, D)

DAY 9 – PARIS~INTERMEDIATE STOP~BOSTON: Following a hot breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the airport for our return flight to Boston (*via an intermediate city*), with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in-flight. (HB)
