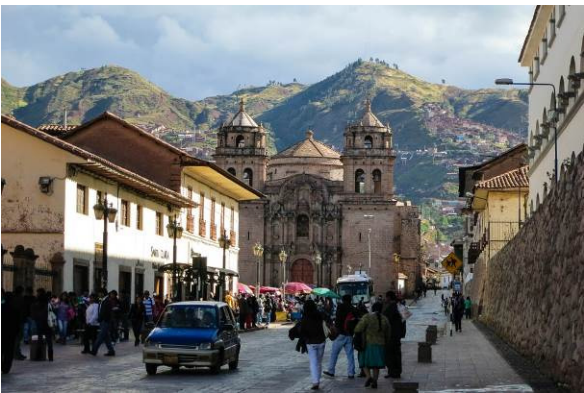

Join us on our fabulous 6-night tour to beautiful Peru in South America! Our incredibly priced program includes round- trip flights, 6 nights' first-class accommodations, breakfast daily, one lunch, one box lunch, one dinner, and full sightseeing most days as described below.

OUR 8-DAY/6-NIGHT PERU ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~LIMA: Depart Boston's Logan Airport on your flight (via intermediate stop) to Peru's capital. Meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available in flight. Welcome to Peru!!! You will arrive into Lima and be welcomed by local staff who will greet you and drive you to your hotel while briefing you regarding the city and surrounding areas. You will check in and rest at the hotel, El Tambo Peru (or similar). *Hotel website:* www.eltambo peru.com

DAY 2 – LIMA: Buffet breakfast. You will be driven to the center of the colonial city, the Main Square, where the Presidential Palace, the Cathedral, the Archbishop's Palace and the Metropolitan City Hall are located. Then, we will make a visit to Santo Domingo Church and Monastery, declared humanity cultural heritage. The tour goes on to the modern district of San Isidro and lastly to Miraflores and Parque del Amor (Love Park), from where you will enjoy great views of the Pacific Ocean. Then you will be driven south of Lima to visit the Pachacamac Pilgrimage Center. Built around 700 A.D as a temple for the worship of the sun god, Pachacamac, it housed an oracle that is believed to be one of the main pilgrimage centers in pre-Columbian Peru. The site includes palaces, plazas that have been painstakingly restored. The rest of the afternoon at leisure so you can rest or explore Lima in Summer season. (B)

DAY 3 – LIMA~CUSCO: Buffet breakfast. By morning, we say farewell to Lima and we go to Cusco! You will be picked up and driven to the airport in Lima for your flight to Cusco Arrival to Cusco, reception and transfer to your hotel for rest and acclimatize. Spend half a day walking about the city of Cusco, ancient capital of the Incan Empire and where we can see the interesting blend of the Incan and Spanish cultures. The outing begins at the Koricancha Temple, an old Incan palace and main center for the worship of the sun god, Inti. Once the Spanish conquered Peru, the Dominican order built a lovely church over this temple's foundations: the church of Santo Domingo that is still there today. You will continue on foot to the neighborhood of San Blas, where the finest artisans of Cusco live and work. Then, you will tour some of the nearby archaeological sites. Start off at the Sacsayhuaman Fortress built of enormous stone blocks expertly shaped by the Incas. It is strategically located at the top of a hill overlooking the city of Cuzco. What a view of the city! Then, it's off to Qenko, which means labyrinth, and where the sun, the moon, and the stars were worshipped. Afterwards, it's Puca Pucara, which might have served as an inn where the Incan emperor and his entourage would have rested and lodged for the night. The last set of ruins is at Tambomachay, where important water veneration rites may have been carried out. Overnight at San Agustin Internacional Hotel (or similar). DAY 4 – CUSCO~SACRED VALLEY: Buffet breakfast. You will head out on the road that crosses the Sacred Valley of the Incas to reach the important Moray archaeological site, elevation 3176 meters, where enormous circular and Pre-Incan semi-circular agricultural terraces were constructed to be used as a botanical laboratory for experimenting on plant domestication and foreign crop acclimatization. The area is so large that at least 3000 plant varieties, including potatoes and corn, could have been grown. From there, you move onwards to the town of Maras (3028 meters) to visit the biggest salt pans in the region that have been mined continuously since the Incan Empire. After this stop, you pass through the village of Pichingoto, which was the top salt producer during the Spanish colonial era, and drive through the Sacred Valley, admiring its corn fields and green prairies, until you arrive at your hotel in the valley. Overnight at Agustos Hotel Urubamba or similar. (B, BL) *Hotel website:* www.hotelagustos.com

DAY 5 – SACRED VALLEY: Buffet breakfast. Tour by bus along the Urubamba Valley, the Sacred Valley of the Incas, to visit the archaeological remains on the village of Pisac, 31 kilometers (19 miles) from Cusco, with a view to the Vilcanota River. The well-preserved fortresses, urban complexes, temples and Andean terraces built by the Incas, create an imposing and unforgettable view. We will visit the colorful market of Pisac, where you can appreciate a blend of color, tradition and local people showing handicrafts and local products. You will have lunch at a local restaurant, and then go on with the tour to Ollantaytambo, the most ancient and continuously occupied village of the

American continent, and we will visit the namesake fortress. Check in and overnight at Agustos Hotel Urubamba or similar. (B, L) Hotel website: www.hotelagustos.com

DAY 6 – SACRED VALLEY~MACHU PICCHU: Buffet breakfast. Get ready for the best day of your trip! You will be picked up and driven to the train station in Ollanta so you can board your train to Machu Picchu. You are going to visit one of the most important energy centers of the world: Machu Picchu. You will travel by train to the town of Aguas Calientes, an experience in which you will see the striking scenery of the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Upon your arrival, you will ride a bus to the Machu Picchu archaeological site and discover this new Wonder of the World and UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site: an unforgettable experience. After the guided tour you can either have some snacks on own at the cafeteria at the entrance and come back to keep exploring on own until 5pm (when it closes) or you can board the buses back to town and check in at the hotel so you can rest after an amazing day. Check in and overnight at Waman Inns & Hotels Machu Picchu. (B) Hotel website: www.wamanhotels.com

DAY 7 – MACHU PICCHU~CUSCO: Buffet breakfast. After an amazing day of discovery among this architectural masterpiece, you will come back the following day (this includes the entrance fee to Machu Picchu and the bus ticket) to climb to the top of Mount Huayna Picchu (2667 meters), Quechua for “Young Mountain”, on the eastern side of the Central Cordillera. This peak shelters another archeological site, the Temple of the Moon, that is connected to Machu Picchu and is a marvel in its own right for the wondrous underground galleries built there. Then you can keep exploring on own if you prefer. Later that afternoon, you will ride the EXPEDITION train back to Ollanta Station, where you will be picked up and driven to your hotel so you can rest and enjoy your night off. Check in and overnight at San Agustin Internacional Hotel (B). Hotel website: www.hotelessanagustin.com.pe

DAY 8 – CUSCO~LIMA~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the airport, where we will board our return flight to Boston (via intermediate stop). Food and beverage service available while in flight. (B)
