OUR PILGRIMAGE TO POLAND AND MEDJUGORJE ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE CITY~KRAKOW: Depart from Boston's Logan International Airport to Krakow on an overnight flight (*via an intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight.

DAY 2 - KRAKOW: Upon our arrival in Krakow we will be met by our tour director, who will assist us in transferring to our hotel. After check in at the *Hotel Novotel Krakow Bronowice* (or similar) we will have a small amount of time to familiarize ourselves with the city, or just freshen up prior to dinner and overnight at our hotel. (D)

DAY 3 – MARKET SQUARE~AUSCHWITZ: After breakfast at our hotel, we will explore Market Square, and hear the silver trumpet of the bugler from St. Mary's Tower. Within the cathedral there will be time to pray before the extraordinary Wit Stwosz altar. The surroundings of the square have remained unchanged for almost 700 years, and contain buildings of historic value such as St. Mary's Church with the famous wooden altar, the Town Hall Tower, the Cloth Hall and the burgher's houses. Tour the Cathedral, Coronation Chapel and the Royal Chambers. After lunch on our own, continue to Auschwitz and the Martyrdom Museum, site of the dreadful Nazi death camp. Return to Krakow for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – LAGIEWNIKI: After breakfast, depart for a full-day excursion to Lagiewniki, the Capital of the Divine Mercy. It was here that the message of the Divine Mercy originated, which Christ Himself wished to pass on to our generation through the mediation of St. Faustina. The Sanctuary houses images of Merciful Jesus and the relics of St. Faustina. We will visit the Shrine of Divine Mercy, St. Faustina's convent chapel, as well as St. Faustina's tomb. Return to Krakow for a farewell dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B,D)

DAY 5 – KRAKOW~CZESTOCHOWA: Following breakfast and hotel check out, we will depart for Czestochowa via Niepokalanow. We will see a Franciscan Monastery founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe and home of the Basilica Virgin Mary. Next stop is the site of Poland's greatest pilgrimage shrine, Our Lady of Czestochowa. We will check into the *Hotel Mercure Patria* (or similar) for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 6 – JASNA GORA/WADOWICE/ZAKOPANE: Following breakfast at our hotel, we are off to visit Jasna Gora Monastery, one of the most important places of religious worship in the Christian

world, for Mass. Known as the Shrine of the Black Madonna, Jasna Gora has been frequently visited by our Holy Father. We will celebrate Mass at the Pauline Monastery and venerate the priceless treasures contained within, including the Miraculous Icon. Next we are off to Zakopane via Wadowice, the birthplace of Karol Wojtyla. We will visit the house where Pope John Paul II was born, which has since been turned into a shrine-like museum. We continue onto Zakopane, a resort village nestled in the splendor of the Tatras region. We will enjoy a cable car ride to a nearby mountain top for extraordinary views. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 7 – CZESTOCHOWA~MEDJUGORJE: Following breakfast and hotel check out,

DAY 8 – TORUN & GDYNIA: A morning city tour of Torun's marvelous Gothic architecture includes the birthplace of Nicolaus Copernicus on St. Anne's Street. Study the Old Town Square, Town Hall, nearby "Pod Gwiazda" house, and much more. After lunch, departure for Gdynia. (BB, L)

DAY 9 - GDYNIA: Morning tour of Gdansk, Gdynia and Sopot. The Old Town area of Gdansk, with its Town Hall, Artus Court, Great Arsenal, St. Mary's Church and lovely burgher's houses, is a masterpiece of post-war reconstruction. Continue to Oliwa for a concert on the cathedral's famous pipe organ. Afternoon free for private exploration and leisure. Lunch at a local restaurant. (BB, L)

DAY 10 – GDYNIA~MALBORK~OLSZTYN: Today we leave for the Mazurian Lake district, one of Poland's favorite vacation areas. Along the way, stop in Malbork, famous for the massive Teutonic Knights' castle - among the best-preserved Medieval structures in Central Europe. Picnic and overnight in Olsztyn. (BB, L)

DAY 11 – OLSZTYN~WARSAW: After breakfast, departure for Warsaw. On the way we will stop in Olsztynek, the site of an outdoor museum of folk architecture. Included is a "Farewell Dinner" with folklore show at a local restaurant. (BB, D)

DAY 12 – WARSAW~INTERMEDIATE CITY~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, transfer to the airport for our homeward flight to Boston (*via an intermediate city*) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in-flight. (BB)
