OUR POLAND AND MEDJUGORJE TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~KRAKOW: Depart from Boston's Logan International Airport to Krakow on an overnight flight (*via an intermediate city*) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight.

DAY 2 – KRAKOW: Upon our arrival in Krakow, we will be met by our Tour Guide, who will help us transfer to our hotel. After check in at the *Hotel Novotel Krakow Bronowice* (or similar), we will have a small amount of time to familiarize ourselves with the city, or just freshen up prior to dinner and overnight at our hotel. (D)

DAY 3 – MARKET SQUARE~AUSCHWITZ: After breakfast, we will explore Market Square and hear the silver trumpet of the bugler from St. Mary's Tower. During our visit to the cathedral, there will be time to pray before the extraordinary Veit Stoss altar. The surroundings of the square have remained unchanged for almost 700 years and contain buildings of historic value such as St. Mary's Church with the famous wooden altar, the Town Hall Tower, the Cloth Hall, and the burghers' houses. Tour the Cathedral, Coronation Chapel, and the Royal Chambers. After lunch (*on our own*), continue to Auschwitz, site of the dreadful Nazi death camp, and the Martyrdom Museum. Return to Krakow for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – LAGIEWNIKI: After breakfast, depart for a full-day excursion to Lagiewniki, the Capital of the Divine Mercy. It was here that the message of the Divine Mercy originated, which Christ Himself wished to pass on to our generation through the mediation of St. Faustina. The Sanctuary houses images of Merciful Jesus and the relics of St. Faustina. We will visit the Shrine of Divine Mercy, St. Faustina's convent chapel, as well as St. Faustina's tomb. Return to Krakow for a farewell dinner and overnight at the hotel. (B, D)

DAY 5 – KRAKOW~CZESTOCHOWA: Following breakfast and hotel check out, we will depart for Czestochowa via Niepokalanow. We will see a Franciscan Monastery founded by St. Maximilian Kolbe and home of the Basilica Virgin Mary. Next stop is the site of Poland's greatest pilgrimage shrine, Our Lady of Czestochowa. We will check into the *Hotel Mercure Patria* (or similar) for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 6 – JASNA GORA~WADOWICE~ZAKOPANE: After breakfast, we are off to visit Jasna Gora Monastery, one of the most important places of religious worship in the Christian world, for Mass. Known as the Shrine of the Black Madonna, Jasna Gora has been frequently visited by our Holy Father. We will celebrate Mass at the Pauline Monastery and venerate the priceless treasures contained within, including the Miraculous Icon. Next, we are off to Zakopane via Wadowice, the birthplace of Karol Wojtyla. We will visit the house where Pope John Paul II was born, which has since been turned into a shrine-like museum. We continue onto Zakopane, a resort village nestled in the splendor of the Tatras region. We will enjoy a cable car ride to a nearby mountain top for extraordinary views. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 7 – CZESTOCHOWA~MEDJUGORJE: Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we will depart for Medjugorje. Upon arrival we will check into *Hotel Annamaria* (or similar) for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 8 – MEDJUGORJE: After breakfast, we will experience the beauty and peace of the simple village of Medjugorje. We will have the opportunity to share faith with pilgrims from all over the world. Some of the activities include the Blessing of the Sick and the items we have with us, and meetings with the visionaries at their own homes (providing that they are in Medjugorje at the time of the trip and pending their availability). We will also have opportunity to climb Krizevac Mountain, where in 1933 villagers built a 30' high cross on the anniversary of Jesus' crucifixion. We will visit and pray at "Blue Cross," a very special place at the base of Apparition Hill which is a place of great healing and graces. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 9 – MEDJUGORJE~SPLIT: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we head to Split, where we will check into *Hotel Globo* (or similar). We will enjoy a panoramic tour of the town built around Roman Emperor Diocletian's Palace, a UNESCO World Heritage Cultural Site. We'll see remnants of Split's Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's Temple, the Peristyle, and the Cathedral. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 10 – SPLIT~ZAGREB: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we have an early morning departure for Zagreb, where we check in to *Hotel Four Points Sheraton* (or similar). We will take a city tour featuring the historic Upper Town, St. Mark's Church, St. Catherine's Church, the Cathedral, the Parliament, and the Government Palace. The remainder of the day will be at leisure to explore the town on our own or take an optional excursion to the countryside. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 11 – ZAGREB~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, transfer to the airport for our return flight to Boston (*via intermediate city*) with meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight. (B)
