OUR PROVINCE OF QUEBEC with SAGUENAY RIVER & GASPE PENINSULA CRUISE ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – MASSACHUSETTS-LA MALBAIE, QUEBEC: Depart our hometown aboard our deluxe, private motorcoach heading north on a scenic drive through the New England countryside to Malbaie in the Province of Quebec (*with comfort stops en route*). Malbaie is located approximately 90 miles northeast of Quebec City. Upon arrival in Malbaie, we will check-in at a first-class hotel. There will be time for rest and relaxation prior to heading to the nearby Casino de Charlevoix. Dinner voucher for evening meal at the casino. Overnight. (D)

ABOUT THE CASINO DE CHARLEVOIX: More than 20 gaming tables including: Blackjack, Roulette, Mini-Baccarat, Three Card Poker, Pai Gow Poker, Let It Ride, Caribbean Stud and Casino War ♦ Over 800 slot machines ♦ Keno Lounge ♦ *Le Charlevoix* restaurant overlooking the St. Lawrence River

DAY 2 – SAGUENAY RIVER CRUISE: Breakfast at our hotel. Depart the hotel for our Saguenay River Cruise! Cruise the Saguenay River Fjord, with its towering cliffs. Some 13 marine mammal species are known to visit the St. Lawrence and Saguenay River area, including right whales, bow fin whales, beluga whales, and porpoises. Among the highlights of this cruise will be beautiful Gaspé Bay, at the end of the river. Lunch is included on the cruise. Late-afternoon return to our hotel, for another evening of dining and/or casino games! Overnight. (B, L, D)

DAY 3 – LA MALBRAIE-QUEBEC CITY: Following breakfast and hotel check-out, we will head off to North America's only walled-city – Quebec City, which is also a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Upon arrival in the city, we will be hosted on a morning guided sightseeing tour of many of the city's most historic and important landmarks. Check-in at our hotel in Quebec City. The remainder of the day is at leisure shopping-and-browsing or exploring on our own. Dinner at our hotel. Overnight. (B, D)

DAY 4 – QUEBEC CITY-MASSACHUSETTS: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will board our motorcoach for our return trip home (*with comfort stops en route*), arriving late in the afternoon. (B)

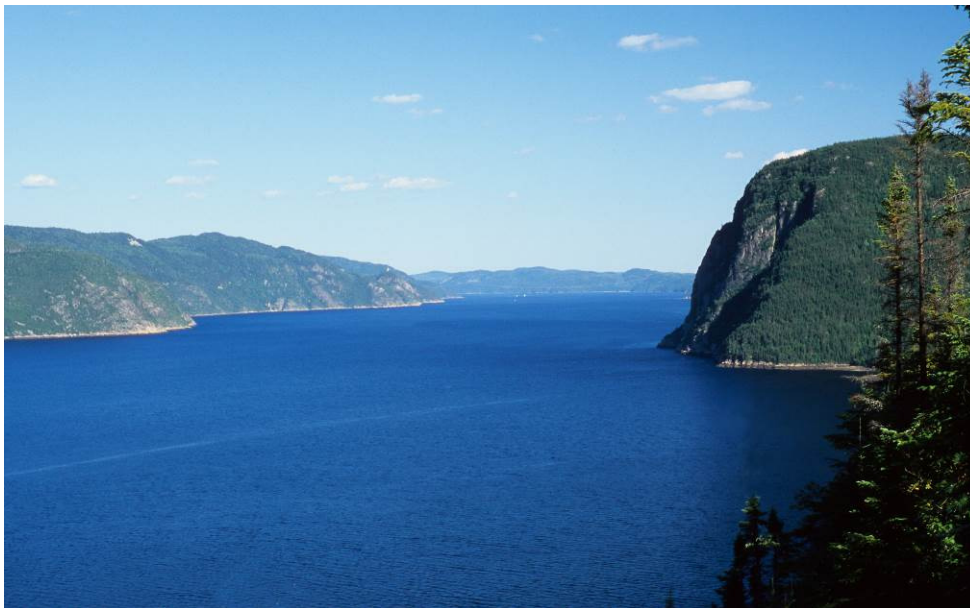
