OUR SAN FRANCISCO & NAPA VALLEY WINE COUNTRY ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~SAN FRANCISCO: Departure Boston for San Francisco (possible intermediate stop). Upon arrival late morning, we'll meet our guide for an extensive city sightseeing tour that will end late afternoon at the *Holiday Inn Fisherman Wharf* (or similar). Highlights of San Francisco include Fisherman's Wharf, Ghiaardelli Square, Lombard and Union Streets, the Golden Gate Bridge, the Presidio, Old Mission Dolores, Twin Peaks, and Golden Gate Park. (D)

DAY 2 – GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE~MUIR WOODS~ALCATRAZ: Full breakfast at the hotel. This morning, we are off across the Golden Gate Bridge, visiting one of America's most spectacular natural wonders – Muir Woods. Here, we will see some of the largest redwood trees in the world and will have plenty of time to walk amongst these giants! After lunch (*on our own*), we'll take a tour of Alcatraz. Then we'll enjoy a stop at an overlook of San Francisco Bay for a spectacular scene of the "city by the bay." Dinner at a local restaurant prior to overnight at the hotel. (B, D)

DAY 3 – SAN FRANCISCO AT LEISURE: After a full breakfast at the hotel this morning, we'll enjoy a free day in San Francisco, to explore according to individual interests. Dinner is on our own tonight. (B)

Later, we'll travel to St. Helena, where we'll have a great dinner prior to checking in at our first-class hotel in Calistoga for overnight. (B, D)

DAY 6 – CALISTOGA: After a continental breakfast at the hotel this morning, the day is yours to enjoy Calistoga and Napa Valley wine country at your leisure.
