OUR DENMARK, NORWAY, SWEDEN & FINLAND TOUR ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON~AMSTERDAM~COPEHAGEN: Depart Boston's Logan International Airport aboard our regularly scheduled transatlantic flight to Copenhagen with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, while in flight.

DAY 2 – COPENHAGEN: Upon arrival we will be met by our Tour Escort, who will help us board our private motorcoach for transfer to the *Radisson Blu Scandinavia (or similar)* for check in. Dinner is at a local restaurant this evening. Overnight at our hotel. (D)

DAY 3 – COPENHAGEN: After breakfast at our hotel, we will enjoy a half-day excursion to view city highlights, such as the Church of Our Savior, Stock Exchange, National Museum Royal Theatre, and Amalienborg Palace. Entrance and a guided tour of the Royal Reception Rooms are followed by a panoramic view of the Little Mermaid. Lunch (*on our own*) is followed by an afternoon of leisure to explore Copenhagen. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 4 – ROSKILDE: After breakfast, we will depart for a half-day excursion to Roskilde, the historical heart of Denmark. Located outside Copenhagen, Roskilde features a Viking Ship Museum and Domkirke Church as well as highlights of Danish culture, folklore, and history. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 5 – COPENHAGEN~HELSINGOR: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we are transferred to the Port in Helsingor, where we board our ferry to Helsingborg for our trip to Gothenburg. After lunch (*on our own*) we will enjoy an orientation tour of the city. We are then transferred for hotel check-in and overnight at the *First Millennium* in Oslo (or similar). (B, D)

DAY 6 – OSLO: After breakfast, we embark on a half-day guided sightseeing tour, including views of the National Theater, Parliament, The Royal Palace and Frogner Park, and entrance to City Hall. After lunch (*on our own*) we are transferred to dinner at a local restaurant in Oslo. Overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 7 – OSLO~KARLSTAD~ESKILSTUNA~STOCKHOLM: After breakfast, we will enjoy the breathtaking countryside of Scandinavia while being transferred by motorcoach to Stockholm. After an en-route stop for lunch (*on our own*), we continue to Stockholm for hotel check-in at the *Elite Palace* (or similar). Dinner is enjoyed at a local restaurant this evening. Overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 8 – STOCKHOLM: After breakfast, we will attend Mass at a church in the city. In Stockholm, we will spend a half-day sightseeing with a guided escort. Also included today is a private tour of City Hall. After our private tour, we will have time for an outside view of the Royal Palace and Riddarholm Church. Lunch is on our own, and this afternoon is at leisure. Dinner is at a local restaurant and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 9 – STOCKHOLM~HELSINKI: After breakfast and hotel check-out, the morning is at leisure. After lunch (*on our own*), we are escorted by to our port transfer. We will sail overnight to Helsinki aboard Silja Lines' *Symphony* or *Serenade*, a high-quality mini-cruise and passenger transport ferry service including regular cruise-line activities. (B, D)

DAY 10 – HELSINKI: Upon arrival, we will be met and guided on a half-day tour, including outside views of City Hall, Parliament House, Presidential Palace, Railroad Station Palace, and a visit to Temppeliaukio Church (Lutheran), also known as "Rock Church," with a view of Sibelius Park. Lunch (*on our own*) and afternoon at leisure. Hotel check-in at the *Radisson Blu Seaside* (or similar). Dinner is at a local restaurant. Overnight at our hotel. (BB, D)

DAY 11 – HELSINKI~AMSTERDAM~BOSTON: We will say goodbye to this lovely city and have our last breakfast at the hotel before departing for the airport for our return flight to Boston with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. (B)
