OUR 6-DAY/4-NIGHT SCOTLAND & ENGLAND GOLF TRIP ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – BOSTON-INTERMEDIATE CITY-EDINBURGH: Depart Boston's Logan Airport on our overnight flight to Edinburgh, via an intermediate stop, with full meal and beverage service while aloft.

DAY 2: EDINBURGH: Welcome to Scotland! Arrive at Edinburgh Airport. Meet with your coach driver and English-speaking guide and depart for a panoramic tour of Edinburgh. Edinburgh, the inspiring capital of Scotland, is a historic, cosmopolitan and cultured city. The setting is wonderfully striking; the city is perched on a series of extinct volcanoes and rocky crags which rise from the generally flat landscape of the Lothians, with the sheltered shoreline of the Firth of Forth to the north. Begin an unforgettable day at Edinburgh Castle, Scotland's world-famous number one visitor attraction at the top of the Royal Mile. View the Scottish Crown Jewels, the delightful St Margaret's Chapel, the Stone of Destiny on which previous Scottish Monarchs were crowned, and many other historic buildings. Edinburgh Castle is a multitude of contrasts that harmonize perfectly. They have evolved into a genuine and magnetic personality that casts a spell on all who come here. DAY 3 – GOLF AT ST. ANDREWS: Today play a round of Golf at the home of Golf – St. Andrews. The Old Course is the Home of Golf where golf was first played 600 years ago. It remains a real test of golf for today's champions. The fabled original links course is synonymous with The Open Championship which it has hosted more times than any other venue and will host for a 29th time in 2015. Despite its reputation and status, it is a public course and is one of seven public courses at St. Andrews Links. The Castle Course is the seventh course at the Home of Golf. Set on a rugged cliff line overlooking the ancient town of St. Andrews, the course combines breathtaking views with a memorable golfing challenge. Designed by David Kidd, creator of Bandon Dunes on the West Coast of America, The Castle Course won several international awards in its first year of opening and was included within the prestigious Golf Digest Top 100 rankings almost immediately. The course was officially opened for play on July 2, 2008 by HRH, The Duke of York and has proved popular with golfers looking

for a new and exciting test of golf in St Andrews. Enjoy the remainder of the afternoon at leisure in St. Andrews. Return to Edinburgh for overnight and dinner at your hotel in Edinburgh. (B, D)

DAY 4 – EDINBURGH TO MANCHESTER: Today travel to Manchester via the Lake District. The Lake District National Park is famous for its stunning scenery, abundant wildlife and cultural heritage. The area's imposing natural landforms are overlaid by thousands of years of human activity. The mix of lakes, farmland, fell, woodland and settlement gives each valley a visual and cultural distinctiveness of its own. The tranquility of the fells, valleys and lakes gives a sense of space and freedom. There is an opportunity for spiritual refreshment: a release from the pressures of modern-day life. Continue to Manchester and enjoy the remainder of the evening at leisure. Overnight and dinner at your the Marriott Hotel (or similar). (B, D)

Host to more Ryder Cup matches than any other venue in the world, and steeped in tournament history, the two stunning championship courses, sculpted from 550 acres of lush North Warwickshire countryside, have provoked some of the most dramatic moments in the history of the sport. Time spent at The Belfry makes for the ultimate golfing experience. Enjoy the balance of the afternoon at leisure. Overnight and dinner at The Belfry Hotel in Birmingham (or similar). (B, D)
