DAY 1 – BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE CITY~EDINBURGH: Depart Logan Airport on our overnight flight to Edinburgh (*via intermediate stop*), with meal and beverage service while in flight.

DAY 2 - EDINBURGH: Upon arrival at Edinburgh Airport, we'll meet our driver and Tour Escort and depart for Edinburgh, where we'll check into our hotel. This evening, we'll enjoy a welcome dinner at our hotel. Overnight. (D)

DAY 3 - EDINBURGH: Breakfast at hotel and then we will enjoy a panoramic tour of the inspiring capital of Scotland. We will see a modern, dynamic city where international festivals attract the world's leading performers, galleries display cutting-edge art, and bars, restaurants and clubs create a lively, cosmopolitan atmosphere with a distinctly Scottish twist. During our tour we'll visit the medieval Old Town, the Royal Mile, and the graceful houses of the Georgian New Town. We will also visit Edinburgh Castle, which dominates the city center skyline, and from its ramparts we can look down on medieval lanes and elegant, sweeping terraces that hold over a thousand years of history, mystery, and tradition. The castle played a pivotal role in Scottish history, both as royal residence and as a military stronghold. After time for lunch on our own, we will visit the Palace of Holyroodhouse, the royal family's official residence in Scotland, best known for being the home of Mary, Queen of Scots. The balance of our day will be for personal sightseeing or shopping. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, D)

DAY 4 – EDINBURGH~INVERNESS: After breakfast and hotel check out, we visit Glamis Castle, home to the Earls of Strathmore since 1372. We'll learn about all the legends surrounding the castle and tour the building and grounds. We'll then visit Edradour Distillery, producer of a unique rare single malt Highland whisky. Then we are on to Inverness for check in at our hotel, dinner, and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 5 – INVERNESS~LOCH NESS~GLASGOW: After breakfast, we check out and head south to Glasgow. Along the way, however, we will stop and enjoy a cruise on Loch Ness, looking out for a certain monster while onboard. Then it's on to Urquhart Castle, which is an impressive stronghold featuring a remarkable amount of medieval artifacts. Check in to our Glasgow hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 6– GLASGOW: After breakfast, we will enjoy a panoramic tour of the city. We will also visit the Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum, one of Glasgow's great landmarks. With ever-changing exhibits, one of its most famous treasures is Salvador Dali's iconic "Christ of St. John on the Cross." Free time in Glasgow before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 7 – GLASGOW~BELFAST: After breakfast and hotel check out, we will travel to Cairnryan and take a ferry to Larne in Northern Ireland. During this part of the journey you will be responsible for your own luggage. Arriving in Larne, you will be met by your new driver and guide and transferred to your hotel in Belfast for check in, dinner, and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 8 – ANTRIM COAST AND DERRY: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we travel along the Antrim Coast where a channel only 20 yards wide separates Tor Head from the Scottish Coast. On the northern coast, the Giant's Causeway, a striking rock formation of 40,000 polygonal columns, is truly awe-inspiring! Learn about the Legend of the Causeway and the Legend of Finn McCool. We will see the famous Carrick-a-Rede, the spectacular rope bridge that connects a small island to the main land. A special treat will be a visit to the Old Bushmills Distillery in County Antrim, where we will enjoy a guided visit and film as well as a sample. Continue to Derry to check into our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 9 – DERRY~GALWAY: After breakfast and hotel check out, we will have an important walking tour of Derry's City Walls, initially built to protect the city from Gaelic chieftains in Donegal in antiquity, but later more notably separating the Catholic and Protestant settlements in the city. Continue on into the Republic of Ireland and on to Galway. Check in to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 10 – CONNEMARA: After breakfast we will visit the Connemara region, a land of natural beauty featuring lakes, rivers, bogs, and mountains. This is without a doubt the wildest and most romantic part of Ireland. We'll also visit picturesque Kylemore Abbey, possibly the most famously

photographed building in all of Ireland. While here we will enjoy an afternoon treat of tea and scones. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 11 – GALWAY~LIMERICK: After breakfast and hotel check out, we will have some free time in Galway prior to heading south to Killarney. En route, we will see two of Ireland's most distinct land features- the moonscape-like Burren region and the famous Cliffs of Moher which elegantly drop into the Atlantic Ocean. We'll then continue on to the lively city of Limerick for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 12 – LIMERICK~KILLARNEY: After breakfast and hotel check out, we head for entertaining Killarney, with a stop in the pretty village of Adare on the way. Adare will provide wonderful photo ops with its thatched roof cottages, which used to house the workers of the local manor but are now quaint stores. Continue on to Killarney, where we'll visit the Victorian mansion Muckross House on the shores of Muckross Lake in beautiful Killarney National Park. Continue on to our hotel for check in, dinner, and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 13 – KILLARNEY~DUBLIN: After breakfast and hotel check out, we depart for Blarney, where will visit the famous castle (and its more famous stone) and have time for shopping at the Blarney Woolen Mills. We'll then make the trip over to the Irish capital of Dublin, where we'll check in to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 14 – DUBLIN: After breakfast, we'll have a wonderful tour of Dublin, starting with a walking tour of Georgian Dublin featuring St. Stephen's Green and Merrion and Fitzwilliam Squares. Then we'll visit Trinity College, home to the legendary Book of Kells, and then visit the Guinness Storehouse at St. James' Gate. Enjoy a free pint in their Sky Bar with its panoramic views of Dublin. Dinner tonight will be a special farewell dinner at O'Connell's Restaurant of Donnybrook. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, D)

DAY 15 – DUBLIN~BOSTON: After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to Dublin Airport to board our return flight. (B)
