**DAY 1 – BOSTON~INTERMEDIATE CITY~NAPLES:** Depart Boston's Logan International Airport on our overnight flight to Naples (via intermediate city) with full meal and beverage service, as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight.

**DAY 2 – NAPLES~SORRENTO:** "Benvenuti in Italia!" Upon arrival at the airport in Naples, we will meet our Tour Escort, who will help us transfer. Board our private motorcoach for the drive to Sorrento and check-in at the 4-star *Hotel Michelangelo* (or similar). The remainder of the day is at leisure to get acquainted with the hotel and our surroundings. An orientation meeting, with "Welcome Drink," will be held at the hotel prior to dinner. Overnight. (D) *Hotel website: www.michelangelohotel.it*

**DAY 3 – SORRENTO:** After breakfast at the hotel, we will take a guided morning walk through the historical center of Sorrento, including a visit to the Museum of Correale which is situated in the 18<sup>th</sup> century palazzo at the east end of town. Then, we will take a morning tour through the hillsides of Sorrento, where wild roses and camellias surround us. We will visit La Sorgente, a picturesque agricultural farm, belonging to the Marciano family, nestled in the Sorrentine hills with a fabulous view of the city of Naples. It is a natural area dotted with orange, lemon, and olive groves and vineyards which have been worked with equipment and methods dating back to the end of the 9<sup>th</sup> century. We'll sip homemade wine, snack on crisp, tender Italian bread (topped with fresh tomato and a drizzle of olive oil), and sample the best homemade mozzarella one could imagine! We will see a demonstration of making mozzarella the old-fashioned way. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure for individual sightseeing, shopping, or relaxing. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, L, D)

**DAY 4 – ISLE OF CAPRI:** After breakfast, today we will visit the beautiful Isle of Capri! Our full-day excursion includes a round-trip ferry ride, light lunch on Capri, and a guided tour. The town of Capri is very chic, with shops, hotels, and restaurants lying along winding streets. The main square, Piazza Umberto, has a pretty white church and several open-air cafés where we can sit and watch the world go by. We will also visit the Augustus Gardens and their magnificent view over the Faraglioni Rocks. Late-afternoon return to the Italian mainland (via ferry). Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, L, D)

**DAY 5 – AMALFI DRIVE:** After breakfast, we will take an excursion along one of the most scenic roads in the world – The Amalfi Drive! Our first stop will be above Positano, one of Italy's most famous and elegant resorts. We will then continue our drive through the ancient marine republic of Amalfi. There will be some free time to visit the beautiful Cathedral of St. Andrew, explore the town, or browse and shop. We'll enjoy a light lunch in Scala. Return to Sorrento for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**DAY 6 – POMPEII~NAPLES:** After breakfast, we will visit the "lost city" of Pompeii (destroyed by the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 AD) and its excavations. We'll enjoy a light lunch here. Afterwards, we will tour the city of Naples, visiting the commercial and military port, and its medieval castle, Castel dell'Ovo. Return to our hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)

**DAY 7 – ROME:** After an early breakfast and hotel check-out, we are off to Rome! We'll stop for a boxed lunch en route. Arriving in Rome, we will have a panoramic tour of the "Eternal City," including stops at the Colosseum, Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona, and the Pantheon. Late-afternoon check-in at the 4-star *Clarhotel* (or similar). Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B, BL, D) *Hotel website: www.clarhotel.it/en\_home.htm*

**DAY 8 – VATICAN CITY:** Breakfast is included this morning, and then we'll transfer to Vatican City, first touring the Vatican Museums, a group of the most impressive edifices with hundreds of galleries filled with art treasures. We will see awe-inspiring relics and works of art donated throughout centuries as tributes of faith. Included will be The Tapestry Gallery, The Raphael Rooms and The Sistine Chapel, which houses Michelangelo's "The Last Judgement". Later on, we will enter St. Peter's Basilica, the largest Church in Christendom. It was built on the site where St. Peter was martyred. Unsurpassed in beauty, a monument to the long history of the Catholic Church, to which pilgrims come from around the world. St. Peter's is the grandest of the world's churches. Marvel at Pieta and Bernini's amazing bronze canopy. Before dinner, we'll have time at leisure, to explore, shop, or sit in one of the outside cafes and watch the world go by. Tonight we'll have a special farewell dinner with operatic music. (B, D)

**DAY 9 – ROME~BOSTON:** After breakfast and hotel check-out, we will transfer to the Rome Airport to board our flight to Boston (via possible intermediate stop) with full meal and beverage as well as stereo headsets, available while in flight. (B)
