## **OUR COOPERSTOWN, NIAGARA FALLS & TORONTO TOUR ITINERARY:**

**DAY 1 – WESTERLY~COOPERSTOWN, NY:** Depart Rhode Island aboard our private motorcoach. There will be a convenient comfort stop along the way. Upon arrival in Cooperstown, we will enjoy the buffet lunch at the historic Otesaga Resort Hotel, on Lake Otsego. Then we will visit the Baseball Hall of Fame. After, we will check into the Best Western (or similar). Dinner will be at Christopher's, a nearby restaurant with wonderful Adirondack atmosphere. Overnight at our hotel. (L, D)

**DAY 2 – COOPERSTOWN~NIAGARA FALLS:** After breakfast at the hotel and hotel check-out, we will take a 2-hour morning sightseeing tour of Cooperstown, seeing such sites as the Fenimore Art Museum, the Busch hop farm, the Farmers' Museum, the Clark family homestead, and many historic houses of the late 18<sup>th</sup> and early 19<sup>th</sup> centuries. Then we will depart for Niagara Falls, stopping at a Duty-Free Americas shop on the border. Lunch is on our own at a highway food court. Upon arrival in Niagara Falls, we'll check into the Comfort Inn Falls View (or similar) for the next three nights. We'll enjoy dinner at Elements on the Falls, overlooking thundering Horseshoe Falls. This restaurant will delight our senses with its stylish atmosphere, open-flame grilling, and stunning views that will make our dining experience come alive with all the elements of nature! The restaurant features the freshest ingredients from local farms and is helmed by an award-winning chef. This restaurant is also known for its specialty martinis. Overnight. (B, D)

**DAY 3 – NIAGARA FALLS:** After breakfast, we'll take the Maid of the Mist boat tour. After lunch (on our own), we'll enjoy the IMAX Niagara Movie on a screen over six stories high. It will let us discover the famous Falls from a completely new and exhilarating perspective! The rest of the afternoon is at leisure for shopping and browsing, individual sightseeing, or maybe visiting the nearby casino. Dinner is on our own. Overnight. (B)

**DAY 4 – NIAGARA FALLS~TORONTO:** After breakfast, we'll head to Toronto. First we'll visit the CN Tower. After lunch (on our own), we will meet our local guide for a tour of the rest of the city, which will include the Parliament Building, Casa Loma Mansion, trendy Yorkville, the harbor front, old and new city hall, and Chinatown, among other sites. Late afternoon return to our hotel. Tonight we'll enjoy a late dinner at the popular Skylon Tower, which overlooks Niagara Falls. Prior to dinner, Rich and Jean will host a reception. Overnight. (B, D)

**DAY 5 – NIAGARA FALLS~RHODE ISLAND:** After breakfast, we will check out of the hotel and board our motorcoach, with many fond memories of our trip, for our return to Westerly. We'll stop at a Duty-Free Americas shop at the border. Mid-morning and afternoon rest stops and lunch stop (on our own) en route. (B)
